On start signal, draw and engage Plate P1 from Box A. Then engage T1-T11 with two (2) rounds each, as and when visible.



RO NOTES: Watch the 180° as shooter passes T1-T4 and T5-T6.







Move to Area B and engage T9-T12 from the left end of the wall and engage T13-T16 from the right side of the wall. Targets may be engaged in any order.

One Procedural for each shot taken at an array from the wrong location.




