

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Bud Connolly

START POSITION: Standing in back of shooting area directly across from the center opening. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 or 8.1.2.		
STAGE PROCEDURE On signal, draw and engage T1-T8 with two (2) rounds each and knock down plates 1-5.	TARGETS: SCORED HITS: START-STOP:	SCORING Comstock, 21 rounds, 105 points 8 IPSC, 5 Plates Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A Audible - Last shot Procedural10 No-shoot hit10 Miss10



SETUP NOTES: Set Texas Star against back berm and adjust the walls and T5-T8 so that shots from Stage 3 pass between them. No Shoots on center opening are to protect fence posts. Wall on center opening to prevent engagement of Texas Star from center opening. Right wall to prevent engaging T5-T8 from right side. T1-T3 can only be engaged from right end. Use two Triple Target Stands and one regular stand in the middle for T5-T8. RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
