



String 2: On signal, step into Box B and engage T1-T4 with two (2) rounds each with either of the two remaining styles.

String 3: On signal, step into Box C and engage T1-T4 with two (2) rounds each with the remaining style.

Top of shooting boxes is Out of Bounds and will be penalized one (1) Procedural Penalty per shot fired.
