Front Sight

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** P.R. Metcalf—Modification by US Design Team

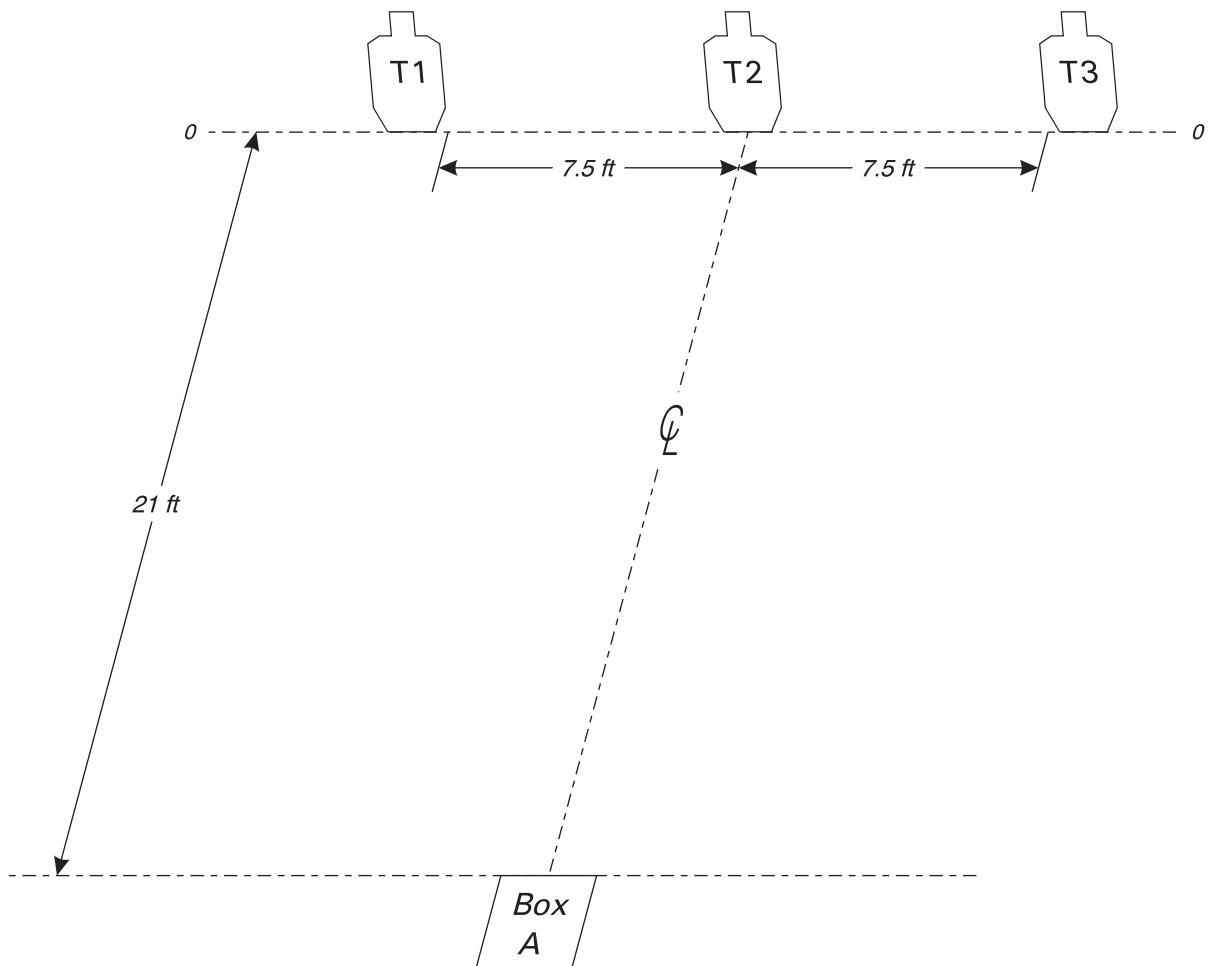
START POSITION: Standing in Box A, both arms hanging relaxed at sides or both wrists above respective shoulders - shooter's choice. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

- String 1. Start facing uprange. Upon start signal, turn, from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.
- String 2. Start facing targets, hand position opposite of string one, upon start signal, from Box A, engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points
TARGETS: 3 Metric
SCORED HITS: Best 4/paper
START - STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Handgun Competition Rules



SETUP NOTES: Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. Angle T1 and T3 to face shooting box.



CM99-23 FRONT SIGHT

Written Stage Briefing

Front Sight is a 12 round, 60 point, Virginia Count Classifier. There are 3 metric targets. The best 4 hits per target will score. The start signal is audible.

The start position for string one is standing in box A, facing uprange, hands at sides or wrists above shoulders, your choice. Your gun will be loaded and holstered.

The start position for string two is standing in box A, facing the targets, with your hands in the opposite position from string one.

PCC, both strings: standing in Box A, facing downrange, stock on belt, muzzle downrange, loaded carbine held in both hands with safety on.

For both strings, on the start signal engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.



Stage 2

Watch the 180

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Breton Rebol

START POSITION: Standing with heels touching marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1. PCC with muzzle pointed at Fault line (red circle).

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1-T13 with two (2) rounds each from within the shooting area.

All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 26 rounds, 130 points

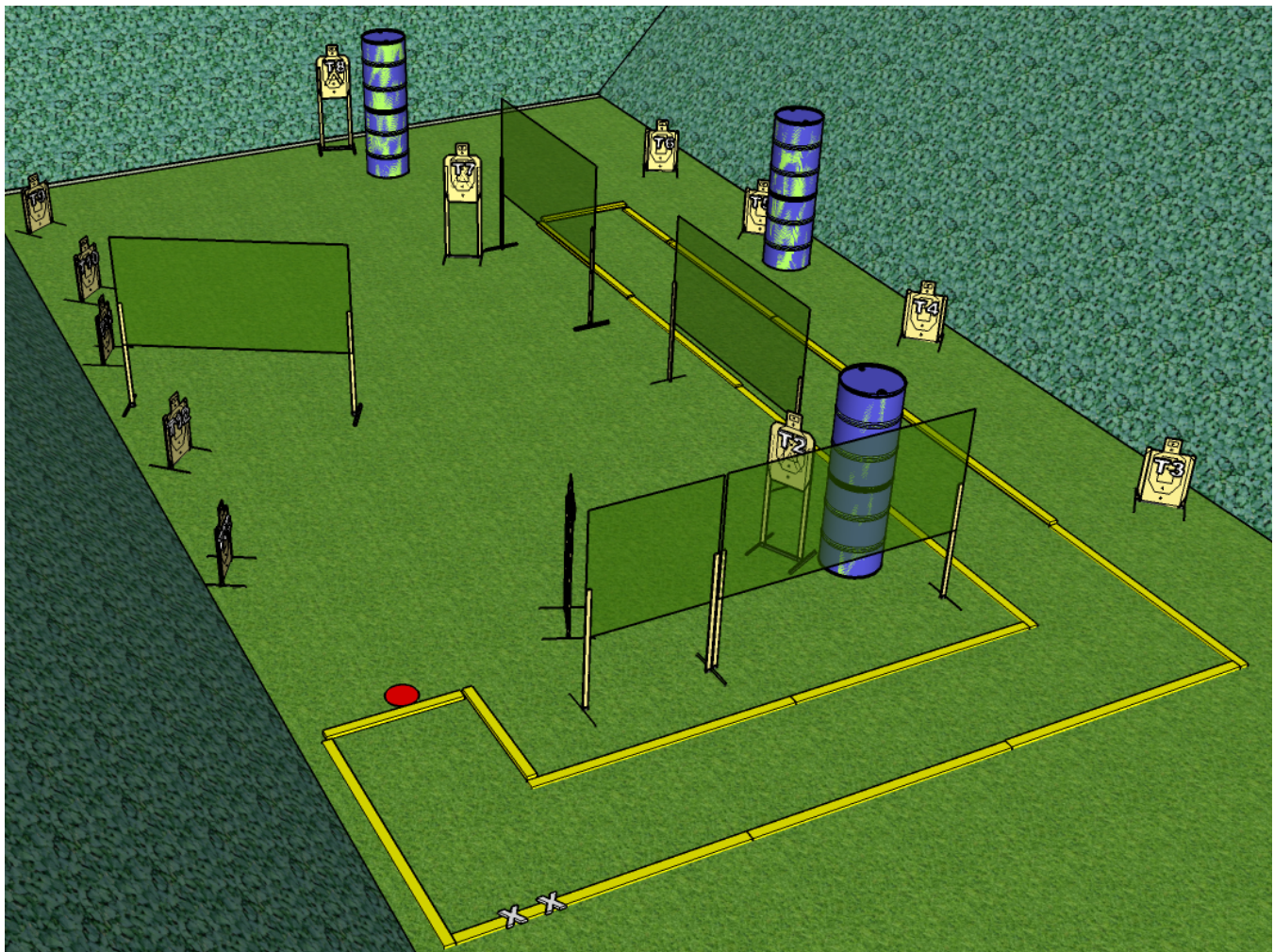
TARGETS: 13 IPSC

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Procedural. -10

Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Targets along side berms are set on short sticks. Watch for shoot throughs with T1 & T2.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults and 180 violations.

Stage 3

Now That's Not Quick

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

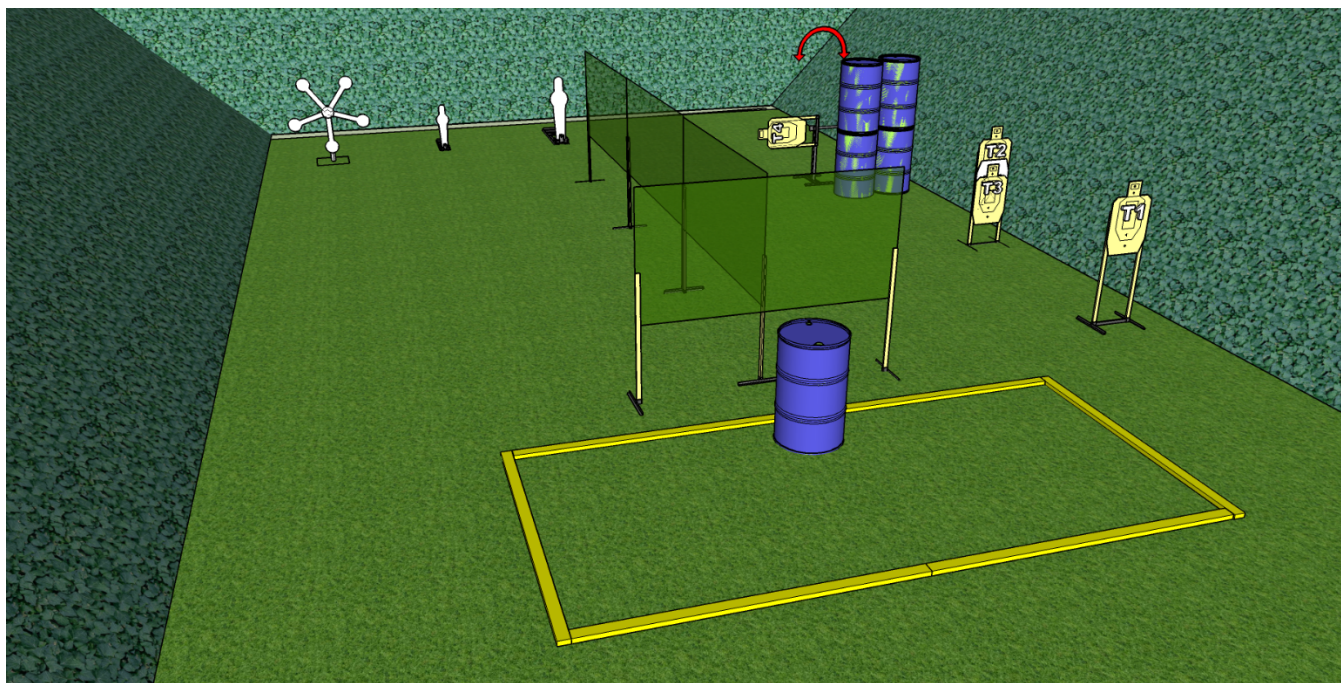
START POSITION: Standing with hands on side of barrel. Handgun/PCC is loaded and placed on barrel with trigger guard over mark and muzzle pointed down range.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T4 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1, USP1 and P1-P5.
All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 15 rounds, 75 points
TARGETS: 4 IPSC, 1 PP, 1 USP, 5 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: PP1 is set in line with fence so that it may be engaged from either side. Steel is set a minimum of 8 yards from Fault Line.

RO NOTES: Watch for Range Equipment Failure on steel and ensure that swinger is set consistently.

Stage 4

Long Shot

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Stage 7 – 2016 WPA Section

START POSITION: Standing with palms flat on marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1. PCC starts with stock on shoulder and muzzle touching wall as indicated (red circle).

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T13 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1-PP3.

All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 29 rounds, 145 points

TARGETS: 13 IPSC, 3 PP

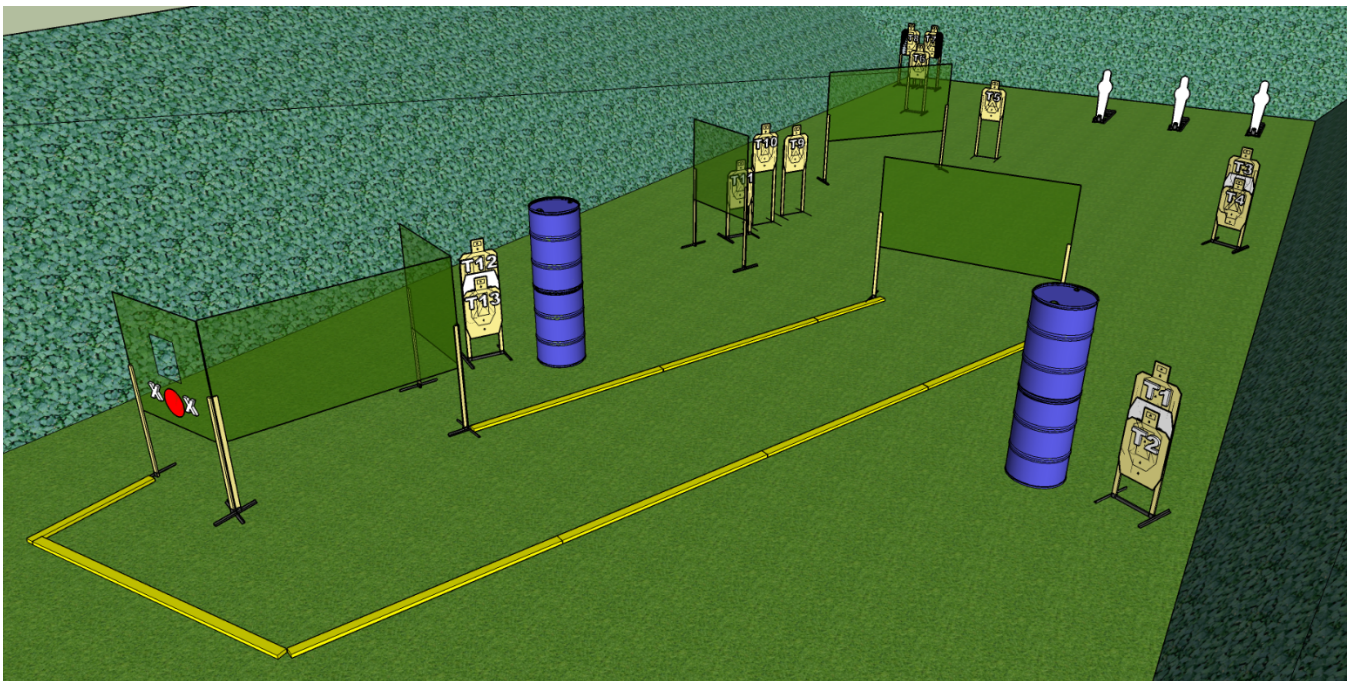
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Procedural. -10

No-shoot hit. -10

Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Watch for shoot throughs to far targets. Ensure PP1-PP3 can be engaged around far wall. Steel is set at least 8 yards from wall.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.

Stage 5

Port Arms

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Stage 5 – 2016 WPA Section

START POSITION: Standing with heels on marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.
PCC: stock on belt with muzzle pointed at base of the wall as indicated (red circle).

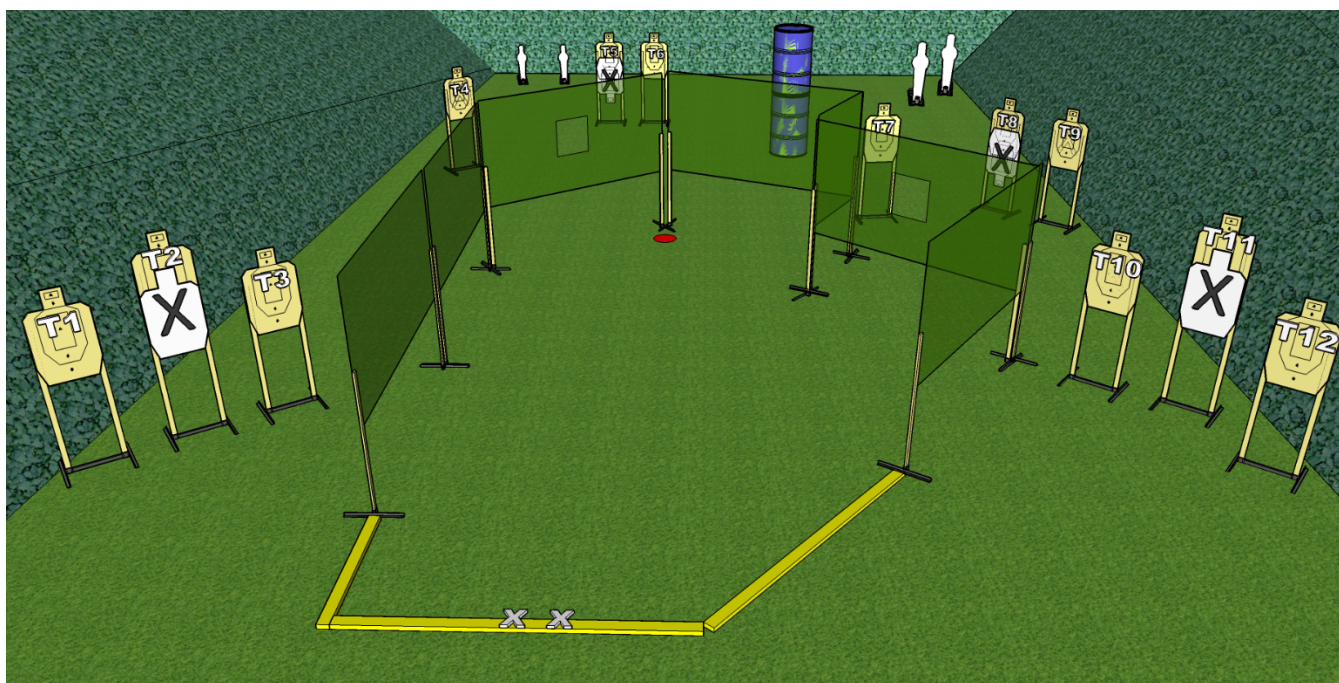
STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1-T12 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1-PP2 & USP1-USP2 from within the shooting area.

All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 28 rounds, 140 points
TARGETS: 12 IPSC, 2 PP, 2 USP
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Barrels are used to block PP1 & PP2 from the left port. Steel is set at least 8 yards from respective port.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults and 180 violations.

Stage 6

Simple

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bud Connolly

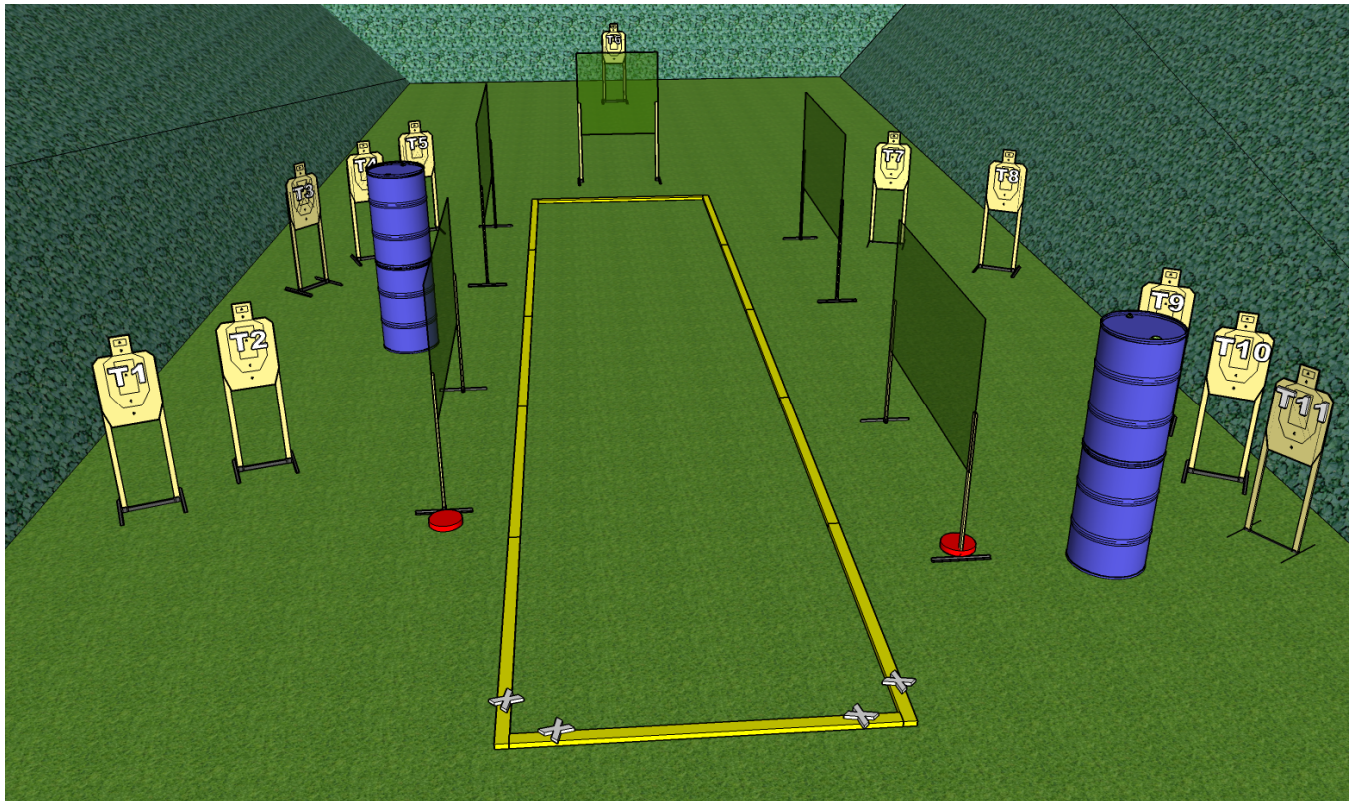
START POSITION: Standing in either corner with heels on marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1. PCC: stock on shoulder and muzzle pointed at base of nearest wall as indicated (red circles).

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, draw and engage T1-T11 with two (2) rounds each from within the shooting area.
All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 22 rounds, 110 points
TARGETS: 11 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Use barrels to prevent engaging all 3 targets from one spot. T6 is set so that it must be engaged from either corner near the front Fault Line.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.
