El Presidente

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Jeff Cooper

START POSITION: Standing in Box A, back to targets, toes of both feet against rear of fault line of Box A, both wrists above respective shoulders. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, turn then draw and from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target, then perform a mandatory reload and from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points

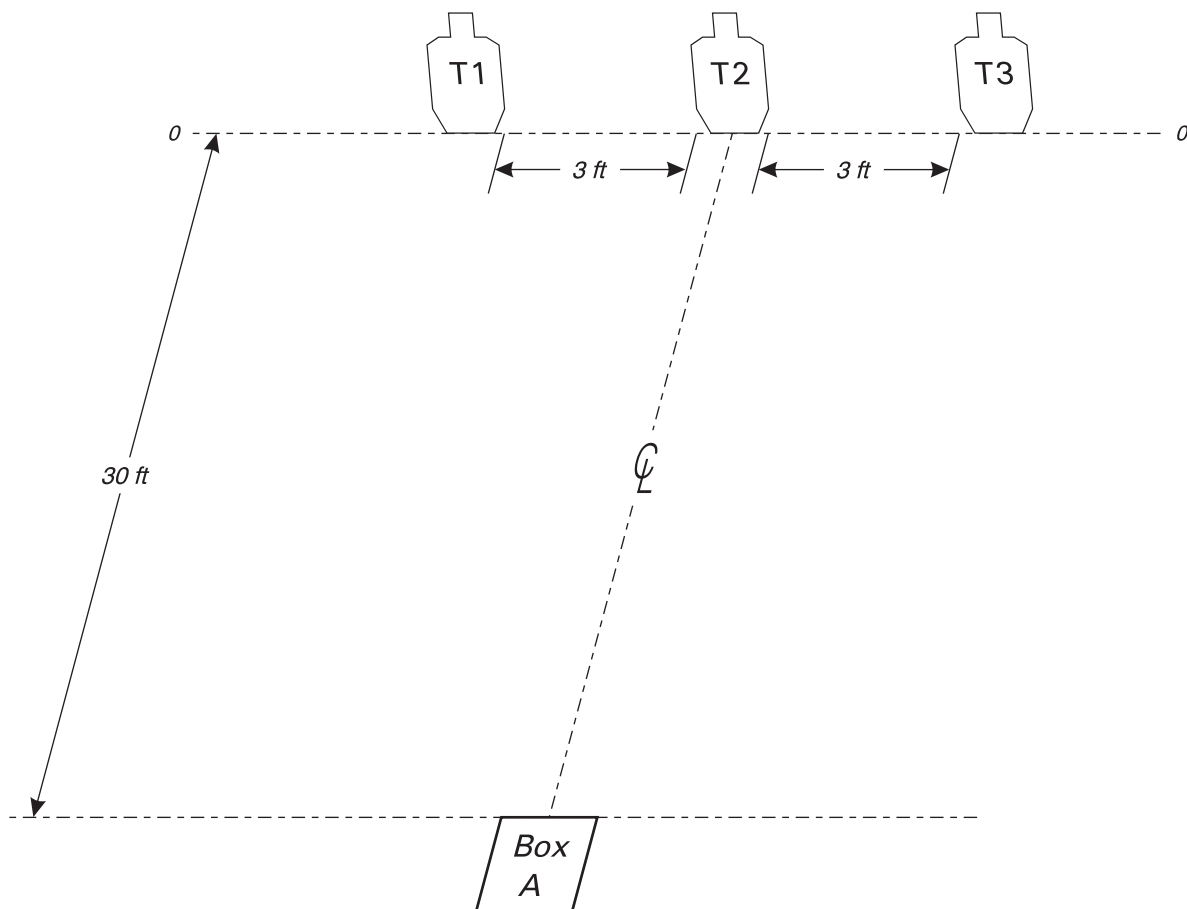
TARGETS: 3 Metric

SCORED HITS: Best 4/paper

START - STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Handgun Competition Rules

Failure to perform mandatory reload will result in one procedural penalty per shot fired.



SETUP NOTES: Set targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Shooting box is 3 feet by 3 feet.

Written Stage Briefing

El Presidente is a 12-round, 60-point Virginia Count Classifier Course. There are three metric targets. The best four hits per target will score. The start signal is audible

Start Position: Standing in Box A, back to targets, toes of both feet against rear of fault line of Box A, both wrists above respective shoulders. Your gun will be loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is standing in Box A, facing downrange, stock on belt, muzzle downrange, loaded carbine held in both hands with safety on.

On the start signal, from Box A only, turn then draw and engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target, make a mandatory reload, then engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.

PCC: No turn



Stage 2

Call Your Shot Brian

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

START POSITION: Standing facing downrange in either box. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1. PCC: standing facing downrange with butt on belt and muzzle pointed at cone.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1 & T2 with two (2) rounds each. Move to other box and engage T1 & T2 with two (2) rounds each. Return to original box and engage T1 & T2 with two (2) rounds each. Move to other box and engage T1 & T2 with two (2) rounds each.

No stacking of shots allowed!

SCORING

SCORING: Virginia count, 16 rounds, 80 points

TARGETS: 2 IPSC

SCORED HITS: Best 8 per IPSC

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

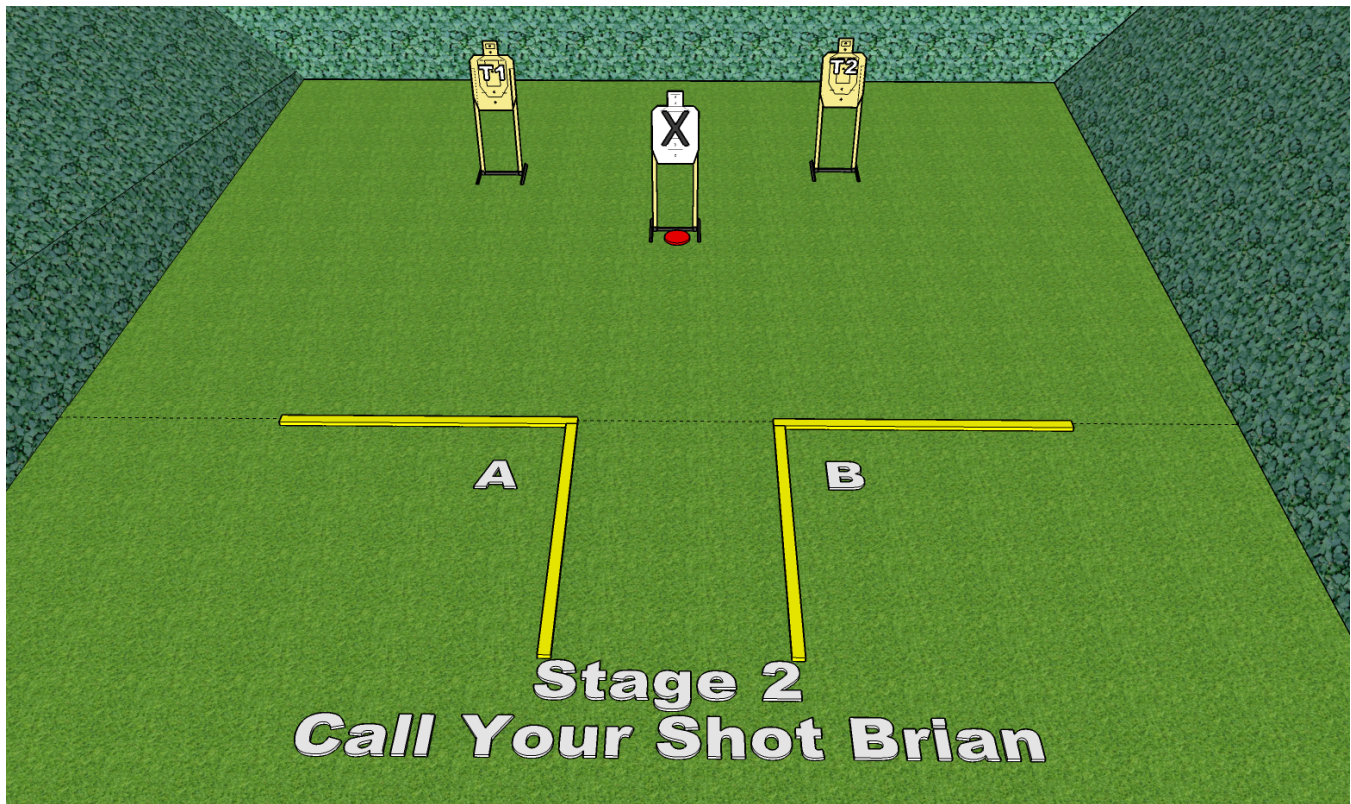
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10

SETUP NOTES: Separate Box A and Box B by ~6' and 7 yards from targets.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.

Stage 3

No Righty Whining

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

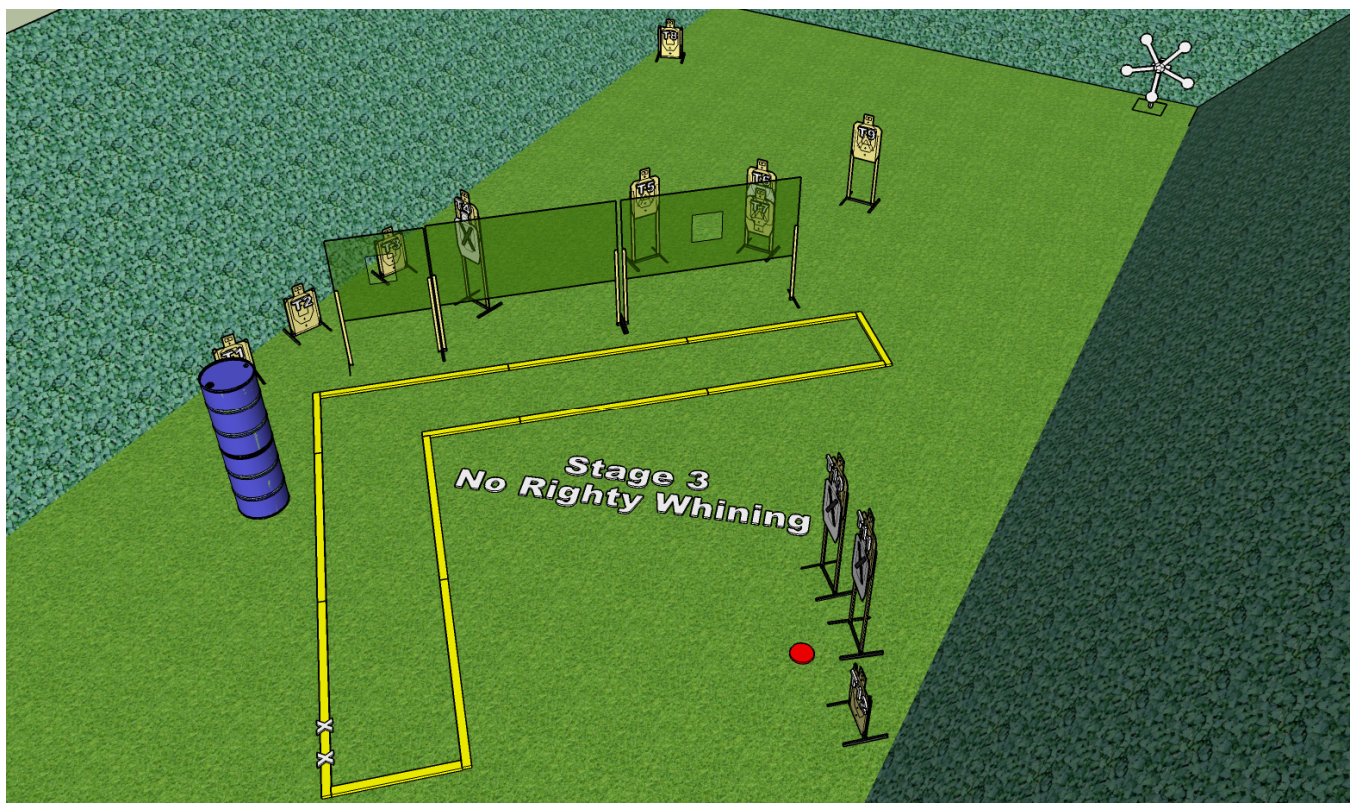
START POSITION: Standing with heels on marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.
PCC: standing with heels on marks, butt on belt and muzzle pointed at cone.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1-T12 with two (2) rounds each and knock down plates P1-P5 from within the Fault Lines.
All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 29 rounds, 145 points
TARGETS: 12 IPSC, 5 Plates
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
No-shoot hit. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Forward Fault Line is 27' from Texas Star set in the right corner. T3 & T4 may only be engaged from left port. T5, T6 & T7 may only be engaged from right port. Set barrels directly across from T12 to use as a 180 marker.

RO NOTES: Watch for 180° violations on T10-T12.
Watch for Foot Faults.

Stage 4

Great Wall

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

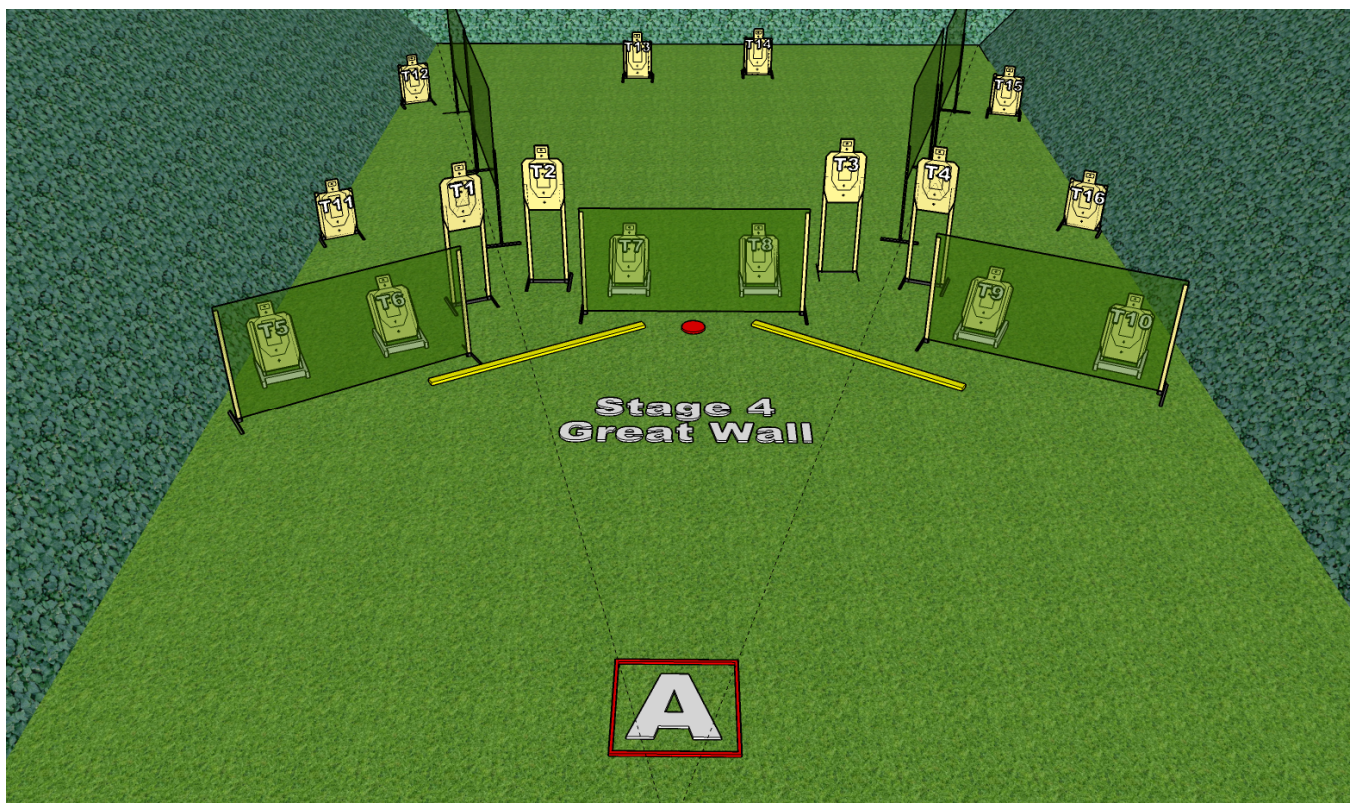
START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing downrange. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1. PCC: standing in Box A with rifle shouldered and muzzle pointing at cone.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1-T4 with two (2) rounds each from Box A only. Then engage T5-T16 from within the Fault Lines. Engaging T1-T4 outside of Box A will incur one Procedural for each shot fired.
All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points
TARGETS: 16 IPSC
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: There are two angle base targets behind each wall. Ensure the hay bale is placed to absorb the rounds. T11-T16 are short targets set near the berm. Be careful of shoot throughs!

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.

Stage 5

Try to Steel This

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

START POSITION: Standing anywhere in the shooting area with hands above head in disgust. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.

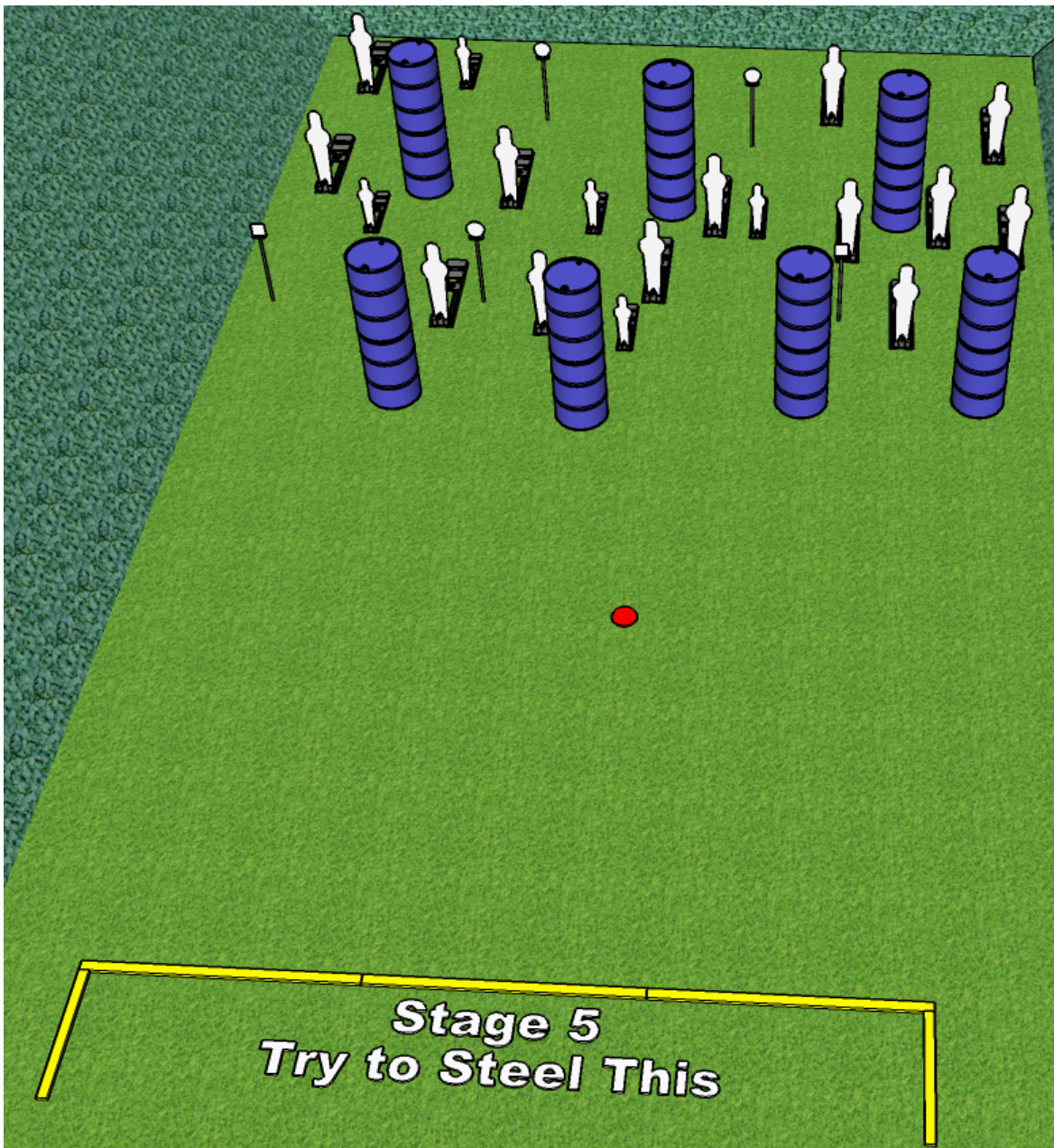
PCC: standing anywhere in shooting area with butt on belt and muzzle pointed at cone.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage PP1-PP13, USP1-USP5 and Plates P1-P5 from within the Fault Lines.
Barrels are soft cover.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 23 rounds, 115 points
TARGETS: 13 PP, 5 USP & 5 Plates
SCORED HITS: Steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
Miss. -10

Stage 6

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

START POSITION: Standing with hands on marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.
PCC: standing in shooting area with rifle shouldered and muzzle on either mark.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1-T14 with two (2) rounds each from within the shooting area.

All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 28 rounds, 140 points

TARGETS: 14 IPSC

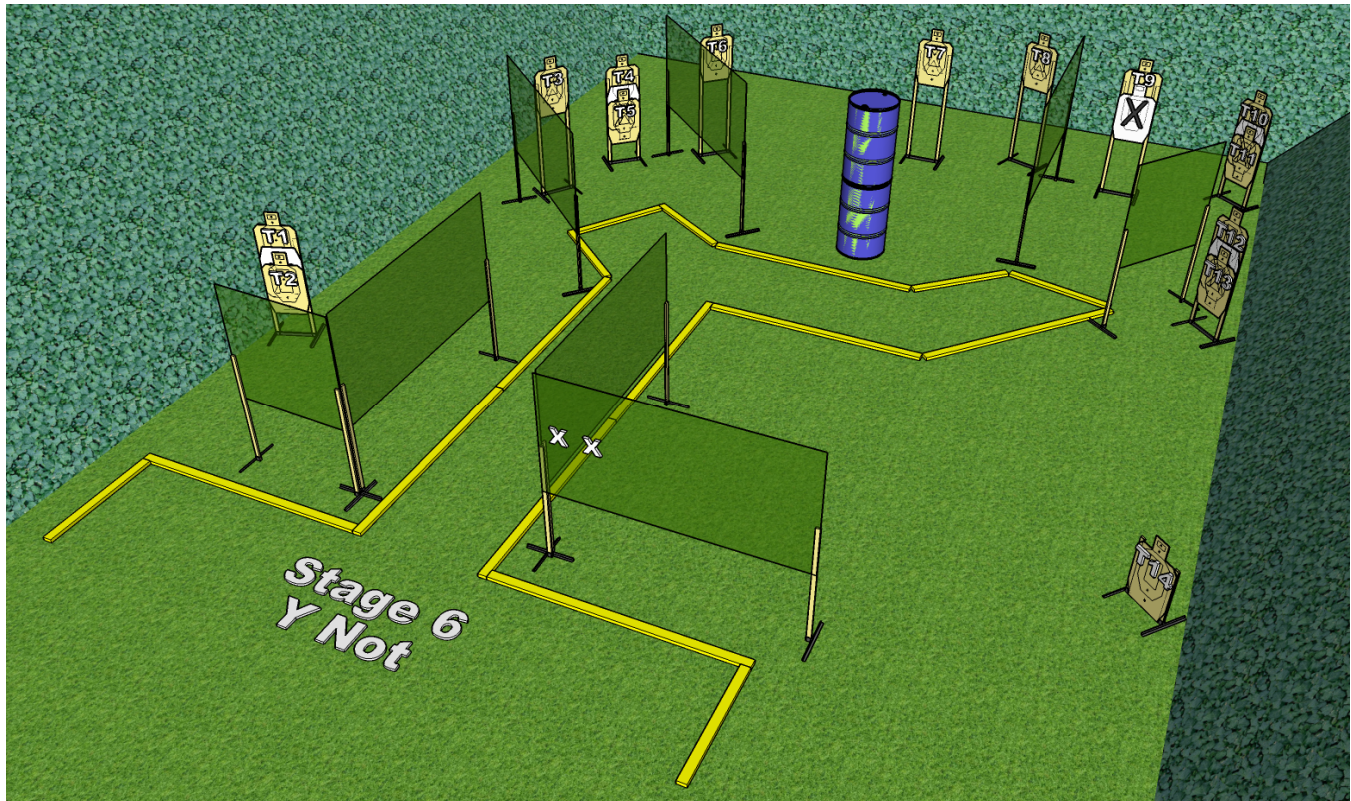
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Procedural. -10

No-shoot hit. -10

Stage 7

Don't Bring a Major Revolver

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

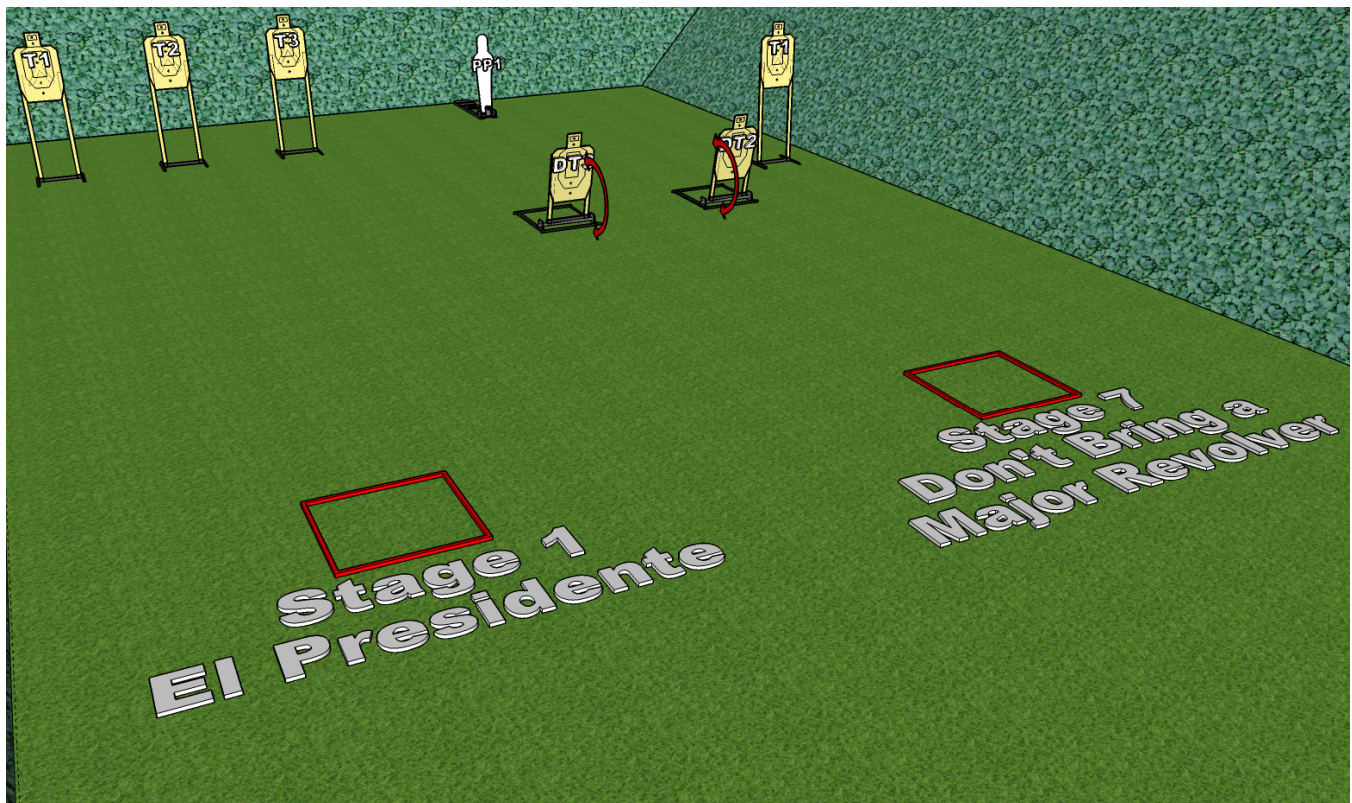
START POSITION: Standing facing uprange with wrists above respective shoulders and with toes touching rear Fault Line. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.
PCC: Standing facing downrange with butt on belt and muzzle pointed at DT2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, turn then draw and engage T1-T3 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1.
PCC: on signal, engage T1-T3 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1.
PP1 activates Peek-a-Boo targets DT1 & DT2 which disappear. Misses will incur No Penalty Mikes (NPM).

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 7 rounds, 35 points
TARGETS: 3 IPSC, 1 PP
SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
Miss. -10



SETUP NOTES: Set start boxes at the same distance.
Set DT2 to appear first. Set PP1 against rear berm. Set targets for Stage 1 ~3' in front of PP1 to minimize splatter damage.
