## Pucker Factor

**RULES:** USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Russell Cluver

**START POSITION:** Standing in shooting area facing downrange, hands naturally at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

### STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage targets with only two rounds each from the shooting area.

### SCORING

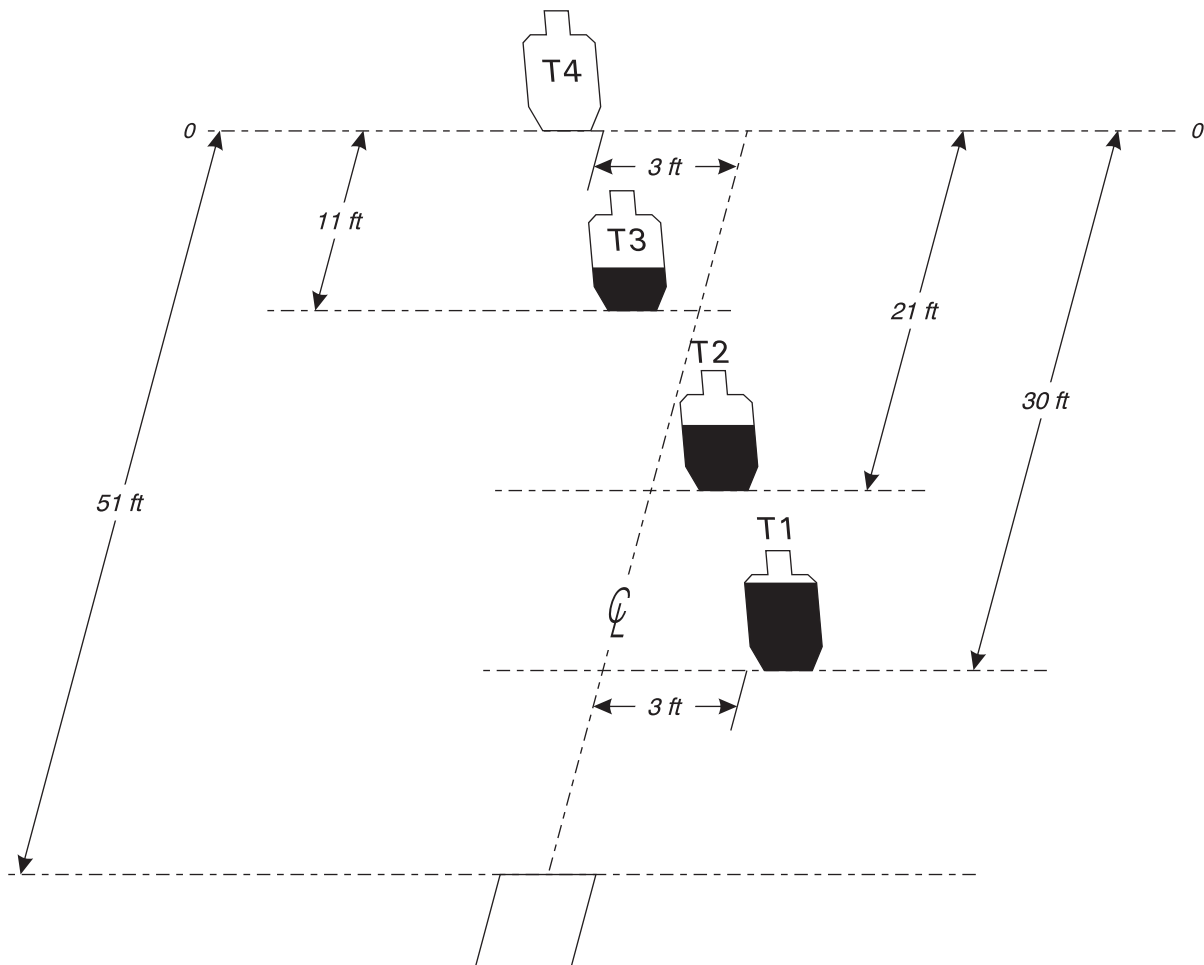
**SCORING:** Virginia Count, 8 rounds, 40 points

**TARGETS:** 4 Metric

**SCORED HITS:** Best 2/paper

**START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES:** Per current edition of USPSA Handgun Competition Rules



**SETUP NOTES:** Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Inside edges of T2 and T3 are six inches from the center line. Hard cover on T1 covers to top of A-zone. Hard cover on T2 covers to center of A-zone. Hard cover on T3 covers to bottom of A-zone.



## 09-04          Pucker Factor

### Written Stage Briefing

Pucker Factor is an 8 round, 40 point Virginia Count Short classifier course. There are 4 Metric targets. The best 2 hits per target will score. The start signal is audible.

Your start position is standing within the fault lines, facing downrange, your hands relaxed at your sides. Your gun will be loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is standing within the fault lines, facing downrange, stock on belt, muzzle downrange, loaded carbine held in both hands with safety on.

On the start signal, draw and engage each target with only 2 rounds each, freestyle, while remaining within the fault lines.

# Stage 2 Not Your Average Memory Stage

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

**START POSITION:** Standing with heels on marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.  
PCC: standing with heels on marks, butt on belt and muzzle pointed at cone.

## STAGE PROCEDURE

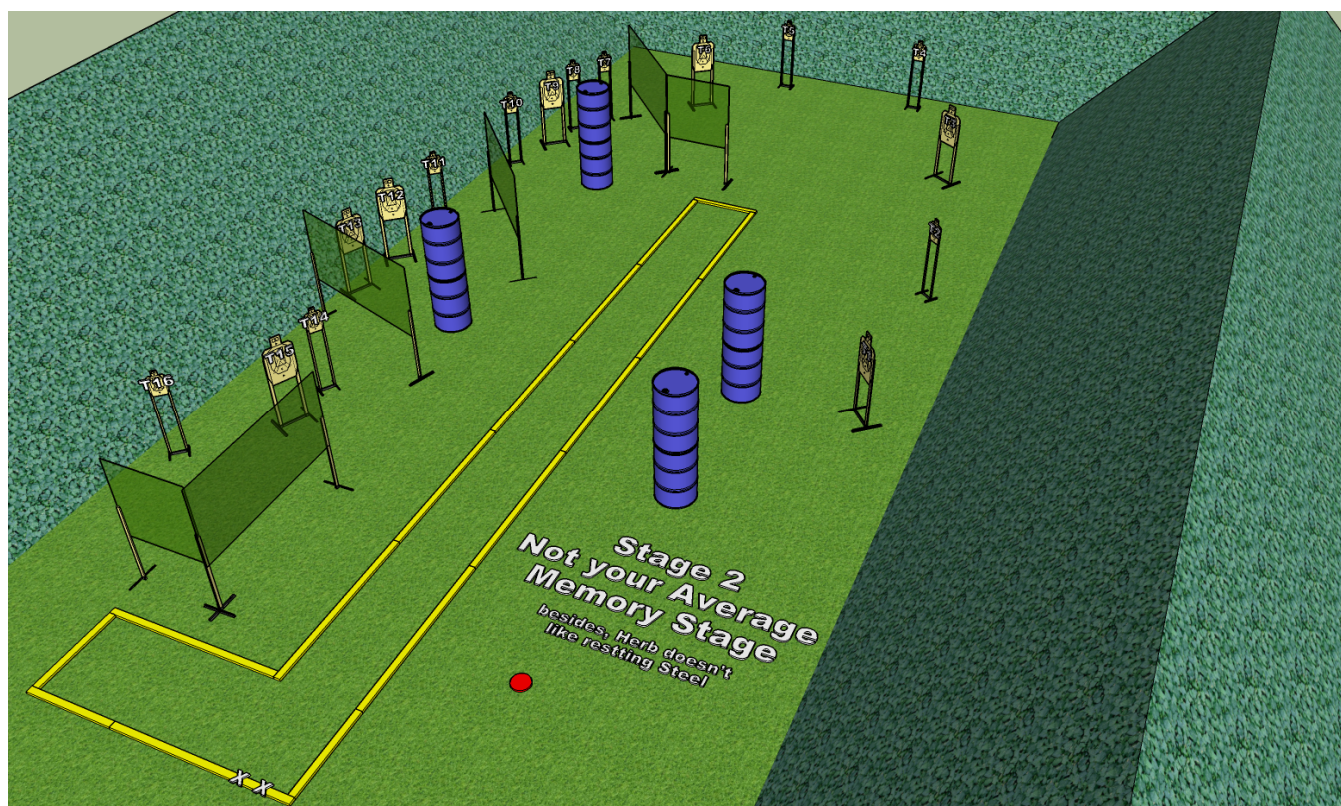
On signal, engage full size metric targets with two (2) rounds each and each ½ size metric target with one (1) round each from within the shooting area.

**Watch your 180!**

All walls extend vertically to infinity.

## SCORING

**SCORING:** Virginia count, 23 rounds, 115 points  
**TARGETS:** 7 IPSC, 9 ½ size IPSC  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC, 1 per ½ size IPSC  
**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10  
Extra shot. -10  
Extra hit. -10  
Miss. -10



**SETUP NOTES:** Ensure that ½ size targets are in the correct sequence. T16 is set so that it may only be engaged from the back-left corner. T6 is set so that it may only be engaged from the forward fault line. Barrels on right are set to block T1 & T2 from the starting position. Do NOT shorten the shooting area!

**RO NOTES:** Watch the 180!

Start scoring at T1 (First target on right) and go around counter-clockwise.

The tablet is set for this scoring order.



# Stage 3

# July Blazer

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition    **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

**START POSITION:** Standing with heels on marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.  
PCC: standing with heels on marks, butt on belt and muzzle pointed at cone.

## STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1-T16 with two (2) rounds each from within the shooting area.

All walls extend vertically to infinity.

## SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points

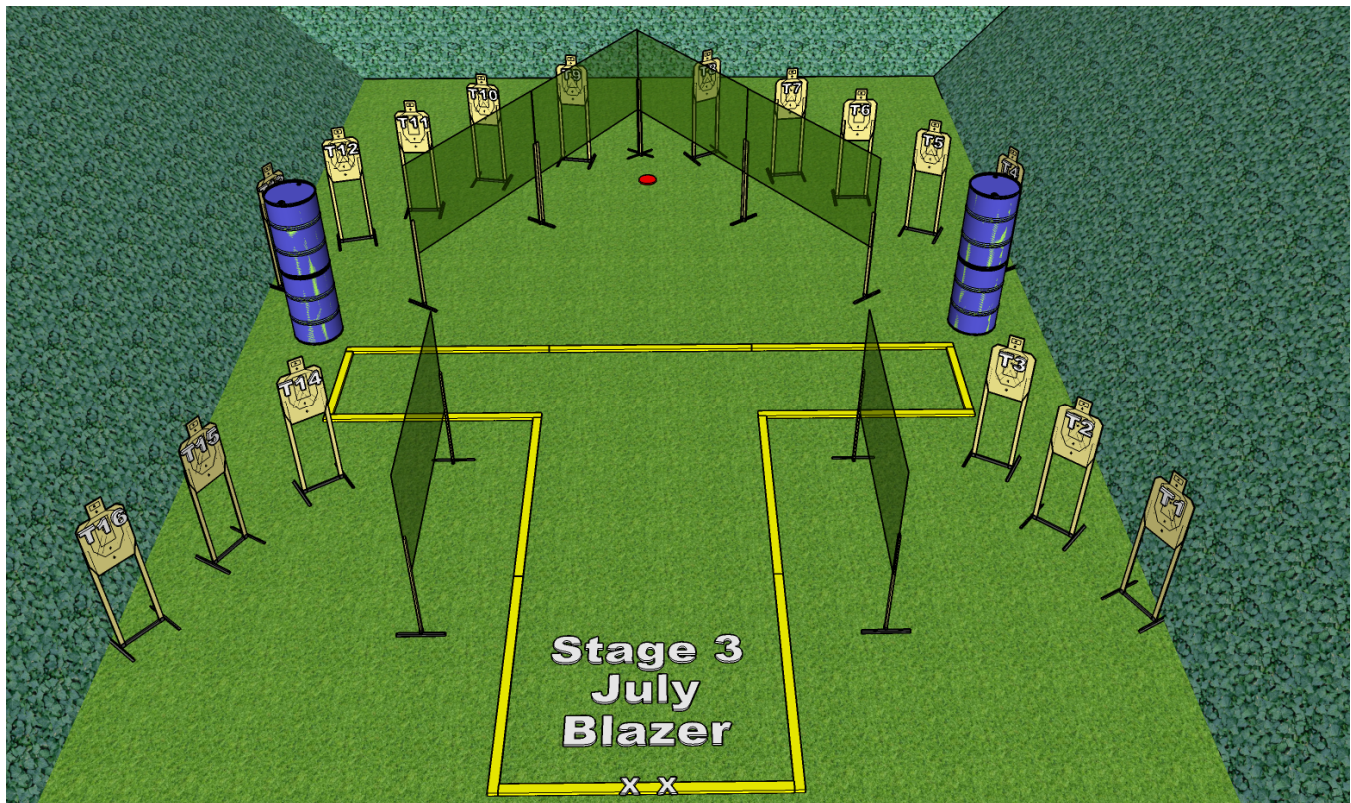
**TARGETS:** 16 IPSC

**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC

**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10

Miss. -10



**SETUP NOTES:** All targets are behind walls on their 180. Use the barrels to block T4 & T13 from first part of shooting area. Should only be able to see T4 & T13 from horizontal section of shooting area.

**RO NOTES:** Stay out of horizontal shooting area until competitor moves to the 2<sup>nd</sup> position.



# Stage 4

# Lucky #7

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition    **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

**START POSITION:** Standing with heels on marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.  
PCC: standing with heels on marks, butt on belt and muzzle pointed at cone.

## STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1-T11 with two (2) rounds each and knock down Plates P1-P5.

All walls extend vertically to infinity.

## SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 27 rounds, 135 points

**TARGETS:** 11 IPSC, 5 Plates

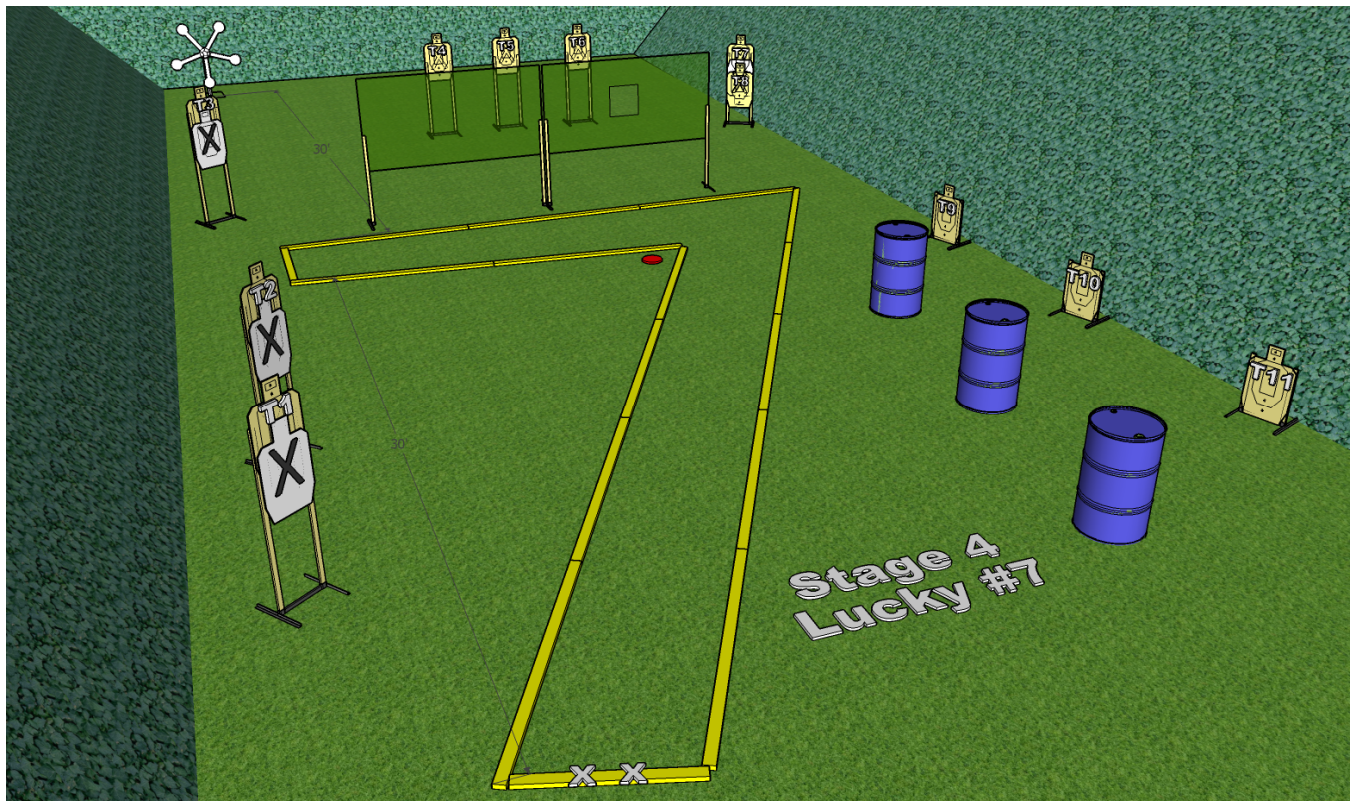
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A

**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10

No-shoot hit. -10

Miss. -10



**SETUP NOTES:** Texas Star is 30' from forward Fault Line. Set T4, T5 & T6 so that they may only be engaged through the port. Set barrels so that T9 & T10 cannot be engaged from the start position. There is 30' from forward shooting area to the starting position Fault Lines. Do NOT shorten! Look at the diagram.

**RO NOTES:** Watch the 180° and for Foot Faults.



# Stage 5

# Retreat II

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition    **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

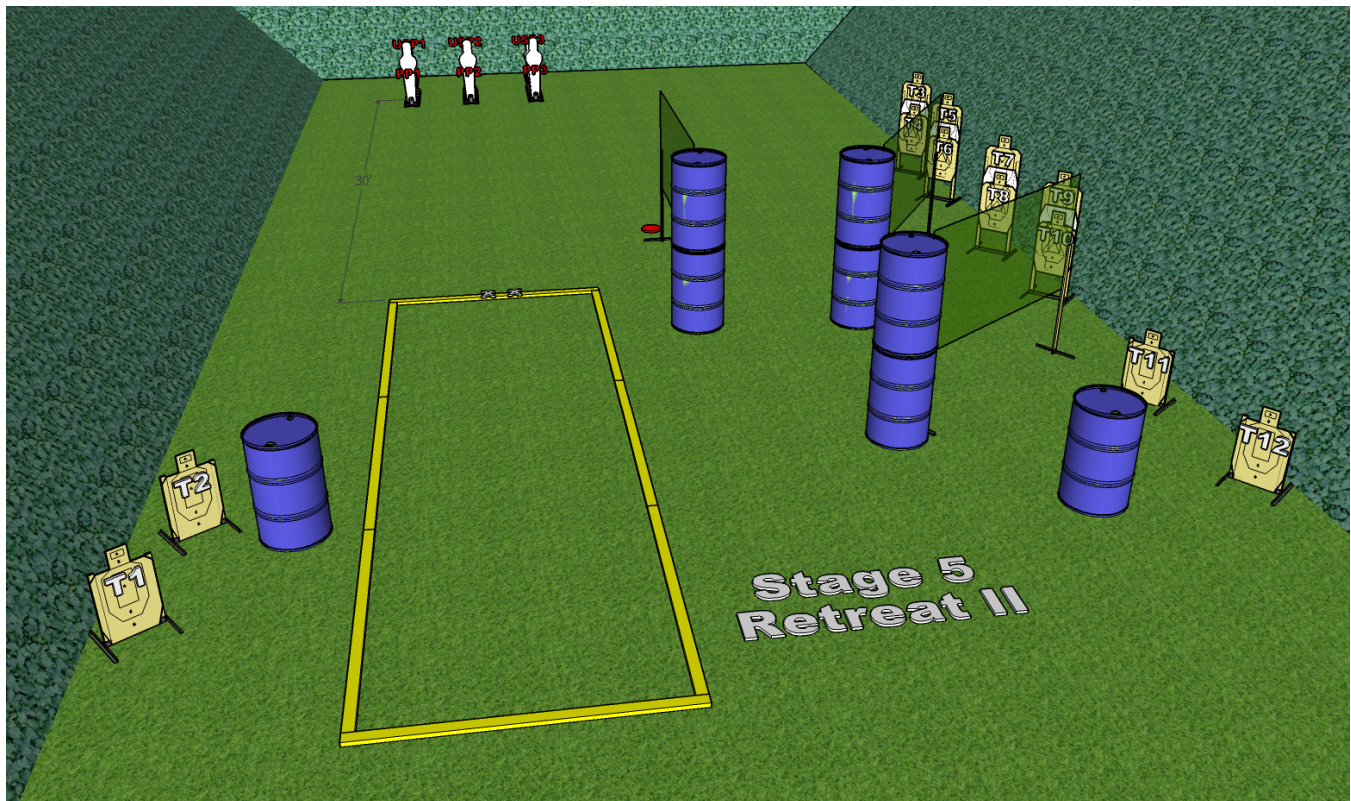
**START POSITION:** Standing with toes on marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.  
PCC: standing with toes on marks, butt on belt and muzzle pointed at cone.

## STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1-T12 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1-PP3 & USP1-USP3.  
All walls extend vertically to infinity.

## SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 30 rounds, 150 points  
**TARGETS:** 12 IPSC, 3 PP, 3 USP  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A  
**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10  
No-shoot hit. -10  
Miss. -10



**SETUP NOTES:** US Poppers are hidden behind the Pepper Poppers. The Pepper Poppers are 30' from the forward Fault Line. Only the steel may be engaged from the start position. Use the wall & barrels to block T3-T6 from the start position.

**RO NOTES:** Watch the 180°



# Stage 6

# A Round the Horn

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition    **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

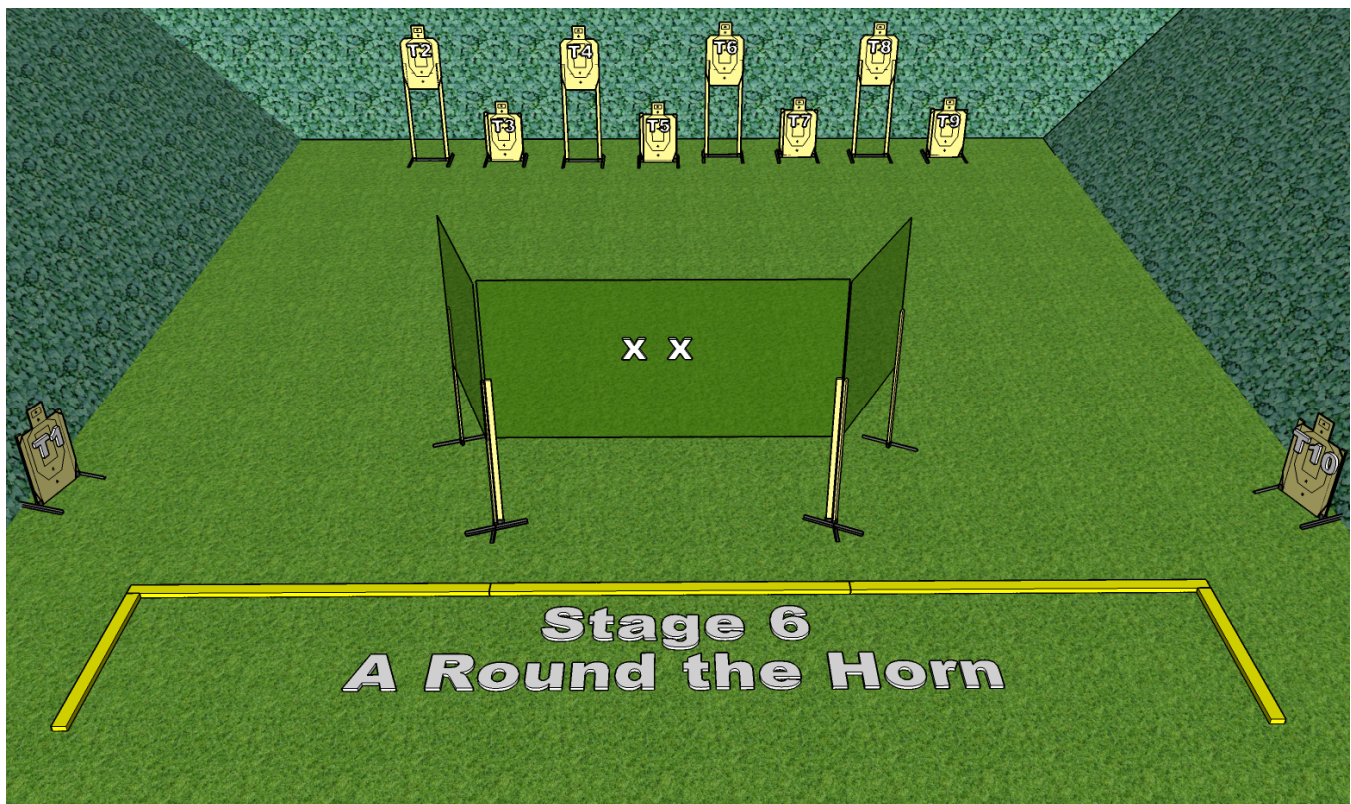
**START POSITION:** Standing with hands on marks. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.  
PCC: standing with barrel touching either mark.

## STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1-T10 with one (1) round each. Perform a mandatory reload and engage T1-T10 with one (1) round each from opposite end of the walls. T1 & T10 may be engaged from anywhere in the shooting area, but must follow the procedure.  
NO Stacking of shots.  
All walls extend vertically to infinity.

## SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 20 rounds, 100 points  
**TARGETS:** 10 IPSC  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A  
**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10  
Miss. -10



**SETUP NOTES:** Adjust wing walls to ensure that T2-T9 may be engaged from both ends of the walls.  
All targets are set against the berm.

**RO NOTES:** Watch for Foot Faults, stacking of shots and proper procedure (double tap on T1 or T10, then a reload).



# Stage 7

# July Quicky

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition    **COURSE DESIGNER:** Bretton Rebol

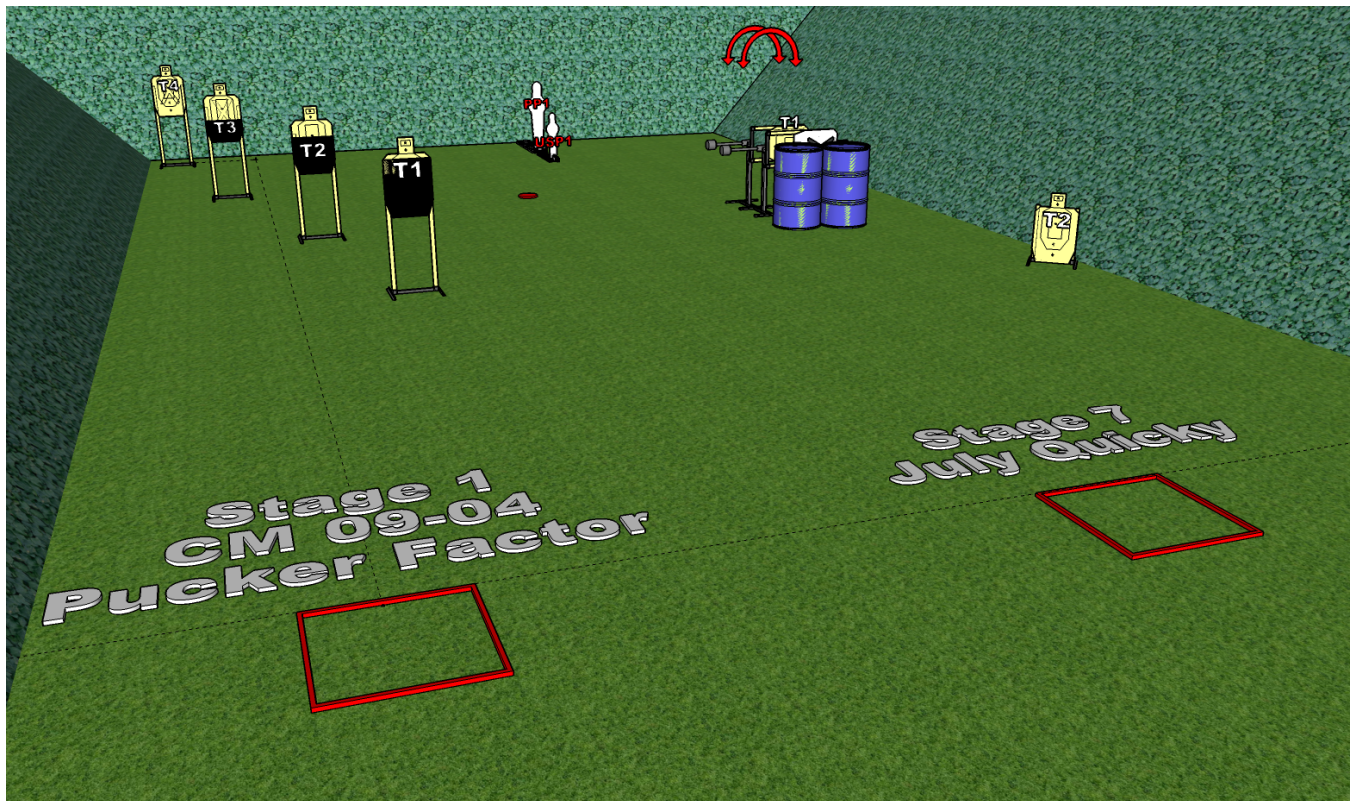
**START POSITION:** Standing in Box. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.  
PCC: Standing in Box with butt on belt and muzzle pointed at cone.

## STAGE PROCEDURE

On signal, engage T1 & T2 with two (2) rounds each.  
PP1 activates swinger T1 which remains visible at rest.

## SCORING

**SCORING:** Comstock, 6 rounds, 30 points  
**TARGETS:** 2 IPSC, 1 PP, 1 USP  
**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per IPSC, steel down = 1A  
**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10  
No-shoot hit. -10  
Miss. -10



**SETUP NOTES:** Swinger T1 is set so that the head is visible at rest. Ensure there is a delay between the activation of the swingers (No Shoot delayed). Set PP1 & USP1 between T3 & T4 T2 of Stage 1 – CM 09-04 Pucker Factor.

Shooting boxes are set across from each other. Stage 1 is set as far left as possible.

The swingers are set roughly between T1 & T2 of Stage 1 – CM 09-04 Pucker Factor.

T2 is set against the side berm about halfway between the barrels and the shooting box.

**RO NOTES:** Check the No Shoot first, before scoring T1.
