RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, Current Edition COURSE DESIGNER: Robert Porter

START POSITION: Standing inside the fault lines, toes touching marks, facing uprange, wrists above respective shoulders. Gun is loaded and holstered.

STAGE PROCEDURE

Upon start signal, turn, then draw and engage either the upper or lower three targets with only two rounds each, perform a mandatory reload, and engage the remaining three-target array with only two rounds each from within the box.


SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points

TARGETS: 6 Metric
SCORED HITS: Best 2/paper
START - STOP: Audible - Last Shot

PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSAHandgun

Competition Rules



SETUP NOTES: Targets are set at 31 feet from the front of the shooting box, and are spaced 9 inches apart, edge to edge. The shoulders of T1, T3, and T5 are at 66 inches. The shoulders of the no-shoots are at 55 inches. Set the top edges of T2, T4, and T6 at 7.5 inches below



the top edge of the no-shoot.) All targets must be aligned vertically, edge to edge. The shooting box is a standard 3 foot by 3 foot box. The X marks are to be 12 inches in from each side of the box.

Written Stage Briefing

Disaster Factor is a 12 round, 60 point Virginia Count classifier course. There are 6 Metric targets. The best 2 hits per target will score. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing inside the fault lines, facing uprange with your wrists above your respective shoulders, toes touching the marks. Your gun will be loaded and holstered. PCC start position is standing inside the fault lines, facing downrange, stock on belt, muzzle downrange, loaded carbine held in both hands with safety on.

On the start signal, turn then draw and engage either the upper or lower three target array with only 2 rounds per target, make a mandatory reload and engage the other 3 target array with only 2 rounds per target while remaining in the shooting area. No turn for PCC.


You may engage the targets in each array in any order, but must make a reload before changing arrays.

butt on belt with muzzle pointed safely downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T13 with two (2) rounds each from

within the shooting area.

All walls extend vertically to infinity.



START POSITION: Standing behind table with unloaded pistol or PCC on table with the muzzle pointed safely downrange. First magazine may be on the table or on the belt. Pistol or PCC may not be propped up by any means. Bag is held in weak hand.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T10 with two (2) rounds each and knock down PP1-PP3 & MP1-MP3. Bag must be carried to either barrel and placed in the barrel before the last shot or incur two (2) Procedural Penalties.

All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING






SETUP NOTES: Start with MP3 ~3 yards from left berm and as close to back berm as possible. In a straight line, place the remaining poppers as close together as possible without causing failure when a popper falls. Then place the front Fault Line 8 yards from PP1. Place barrel next to T5 to prevent splatter damage only. Do not block T5 from any shooting

location.

START POSITION: Standing with heels touching rear fault line on opposite sides of mark. Handgun is loaded and

holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.

PCC is loaded, held in both hands with safety on and butt on belt with muzzle pointed at cone.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T12 with two (2) rounds each and knock down plates P1-P5 from within the shooting area.

All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 29 rounds, 145 points



START-STOP: Audible - Last shot **PENALTIES:** Procedural. -10

SETUP NOTES: Place Texas Star at the center of the bay as far back as possible. Make sure star is placed on a flat location and that both bolts are tightened on the support post. Front of shooting area is 8 yards from the star.

RO NOTES: Watch for Foot Faults.

START POSITION: Standing Facing Downrange. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1. PCC is loaded, held in both hands with butt on belt and muzzle pointed at cone.

STAGE PROCEDURE

String 1: On start signal, engage T1-T4 with two (2) rounds each Freestyle. Perform a mandatory reload and engage T1-T4 with one (1) round each Strong Hand ONLY.

String 2: On start signal, engage T1-T4 with one (1) round each Freestyle. Perform a mandatory reload and engage T1-T4 with two (2) rounds each Weak Hand ONLY (PCC is weak shoulder only).



PCC is unloaded, held in both hands with muzzle touching either mark.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage T1-T16 with two (2) rounds each.

All walls extend vertically to infinity.

SCORING: Comstock, 32 rounds, 160 points


