### **Can You Count**

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition COURSE DESIGNER: Mark Ramsey and John Golson

**START POSITION:** Standing erect in Box A, arms hanging naturally at sides. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

#### **STAGE PROCEDURE**

On signal, from Box A only:

String 1: Engage T1 with five rounds only. Perform a

 $mandatory\,reload\,and\,engage\,T2\,with\,five\,rounds$ 

only

String 2: Engage T3 with five rounds only. Perform a

mandatory reload and engage T4 with five rounds

oniy.

Targets within a string may be engaged in any order without penalty

#### SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 20 rounds, 100 points

TARGETS: 4 Metric
SCORED HITS: Best 5/paper


**START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current edition of USPSA Hand-

gun Competition Rules

Failure to perform reload is per-shot-

fired penalty.



**SETUP NOTES:** Set targets T1 and T4 to 4 feet high at shoulders and angled at 45 degrees from the center line. Set targets T2 and T3 to 5 feet at shoulders. Scoring lines of no-shoots overlay C-zone scoring lines



of targets. Bottom of no-shoot is even with bottom of target. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet.

#### **Written Stage Briefing**

Can You Count is a 20 round, 100 point Virginia count classifier course. There are 4 metric targets. The best 5 hits per paper will score. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing in Box A, facing downrange, hands naturally at your side. Your handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is standing in Box A, facing downrange, stock on belt, muzzle downrange, loaded carbine held in both hands with safety on.

On the audible start signal from within the fault lines:

String 1: Engage T1 with 5 rounds only, perform a mandatory reload and engage T2 with 5 rounds only.


String 2: Engage T3 with 5 rounds only, perform a mandatory reload and engage T4 with 5 rounds only.

## **October Blazer**

SCORING: This is a 32 round, 160 point, Comstock course of fire.

**TARGETS**: 16 USPSA targets

**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per USPSA **START-STOP**: Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES**: Per the current edition of the USPSA Rule Book.


**STARTING POSITION:** Facing downrange standing anywhere in the shooting area. Handgun

is unloaded and holstered.

PCC is facing downrange standing anywhere in the shooting area. PCC is unloaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt and muzzle pointed downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Upon start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area.

# Stage 3 If You Have To Go, Do It Fast

**SCORING**: This is a 20 round, 100 point, Comstock course of fire.

**TARGETS**: 9 USPSA targets, 2 USPSA Poppers

**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot


**PENALTIES**: Per the current edition of the USPSA Rule Book.

**STARTING POSITION:** Facing downrange, with feet touching Start Stick and wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC is facing downrange with feet touching Start Stick. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt and muzzle pointed downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Upon start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area.

## Stage 4 Five & Dime

**SCORING**: This is a 30 round, 150 point, Comstock course of fire. **TARGETS**: 10 USPSA targets, 5 USPSA Poppers and 5 Plates.

**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot


**PENALTIES**: Per the current edition of the USPSA Rule Book.

**STARTING POSITION:** Facing downrange, with strong hand touching the end of the wall and wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC is facing downrange. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt and muzzle touching end of the wall.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Upon start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area.

# Stage 5 Mini Poppers

**SCORING**: This is a 21 round, 105 point, Comstock course of fire.

**TARGETS**: 8 USPSA targets and 5 USPSA Mini Poppers.

**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot


**PENALTIES**: Per the current edition of the USPSA Rule Book.

**STARTING POSITION:** Facing downrange, with strong hand touching either mark. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC is facing downrange. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt and muzzle touching either mark.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Upon start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area.

## **Revolver Friendly**

**SCORING**: This is a 30 round, 150 point, Comstock course of fire.

**TARGETS**: 15 USPSA targets

**SCORED HITS:** Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A

**START-STOP**: Audible - Last shot

**PENALTIES**: Per the current edition of the USPSA Rule Book.

**STARTING POSITION:** Facing downrange, with toes touching Start Stick and wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC is facing downrange with toes touching Start Stick. PCC is loaded, held in both hands, stock touching belt and muzzle pointed downrange.

STAGE PROCEDURE: Upon start signal, engage targets from within the shooting area.
