

# CM 18-07 Someone Is Always Willing To Pay

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition. Course Designer: Nationals Design Team

#### **STAGE PROCEDURE**

From within box engage T1-3 or P1-P2 then perform a mandatory reload and engage remaining targets.

**Scoring:** Comstock, 8 rounds, 40 points

Targets: 3 USPSA Targets,


2 USPSA Mini Poppers.

**Scored Hits:** Best 2/paper, steel must fall.

**Start - Stop:** Audible - Last Shot

Penalties: Per current edition of USPSA

Handgun Competition Rules.





**SETUP NOTES:** Set targets 5 feet to top. Box is 3 feet by 3 feet.

Left edge of no-shoot is lined up with left edge of A-zone, top of no-shoot (not the scoring zone line) is lined up with bottom of target lettering.



# CM 18-07 Someone Is Always Willing To Pay

Someone Is Always Willing To Pay is a 8 round, 40-point, Comstock Speed Shoot. There are 3 USPSA targets and 2 USPSA Mini poppers. The best 2 hits per paper will score and steel must fall to score.

The handgun start position is standing inside shooting area, facing downrange, wrists below belt with handgun loaded and holstered.

The PCC start position is standing inside shooting area, facing downrange, holding loaded PCC, stock on belt, and muzzle pointing downrange.

On the audible start signal from within shooting area, engage T1-T3 or P1 & P2, perform a mandatory reload, and engage remaining targets.







Scoring: COMSTOCK, Best 2 hits on cardboard.

Targets: 20 USPSA targets


Rounds:40

#### **Start Position:**

The start position is standing anywhere outside the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is standing anywhere outside the shooting area, stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

# Stage 2 - Oct Blazer by Bretton Rebol

# WRITTEN STAGE BRIEFING

Welcome to stage Stage 2 - Oct Blazer. My name is Bretton Rebol and I am the CRO for this stage.

Oct Blazer is a 40 round, 200 point COMSTOCK Long course. There are 20 USPSA targets. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing anywhere outside the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is standing anywhere outside the shooting area, stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.







# Deja Vu All Over Again

**Scoring:** Comstock course of fire

Targets: 4 USPSA cardboard targets 2 full size & 2 mini

**USPSA Poppers** 

Rounds: 12


Condition: Loaded and holstered

Start Position: Standing anywhere in shooting area, wrists below

belt. PCC stock on belt generally downrange.

The start is audible

**Procedure:** Engage targets from within the shooting area.





#### **SETUP NOTES**

Targets are 5' to top of target.

No Shoot inverted at 5 inches below A zone perf.

#### CM 20-03 Déjà vu All Over Again

#### **Written Stage Briefing**


Déjà vu All Over Again is a 12 round, 60-point, Comstock Classifier course. There are 4 USPSA targets, 2 USPSA Poppers, and 2 USPSA Mini-Poppers.

The handgun start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, wrists below belt, handgun loaded and holstered.

The PCC start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, loaded PCC held in both hands, safety on, stock on belt, muzzle generally downrange.

On the audible start signal, engage targets as available from within the shooting area.







Scoring: COMSTOCK, Best 2 hits on cardboard.

Targets: 9 USPSA targets, 2 poppers, 2 mini poppers, 2 steel

Rounds:22


#### **Start Position:**

The start position is standing with heels touching Start Stick, facing down range with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is standing with heels toching Start Stick, stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

#### Procedure:

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area. Either P2 or P3 will activate swinger S1 which remains visible at rest.





# Stage 4 - Bad Moon Rising by Bud Connolly

## WRITTEN STAGE BRIEFING

Welcome to Stage 4 - Bad Moon Rising.

Bad Moon Rising is a 22 round, 110 point COMSTOCK Long course. There are 9 USPSA targets and 4 steel. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing with heels touching Start Stick, facing down range with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is standing with heels toching Start Stick, stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area. Either P2 or P3 will activate swinger S1 which remains visible at rest.







Scoring: FIXED TIME, Best 4 hits on cardboard.

Targets: 5 USPSA targets

Rounds:20


#### **Start Position:**

The start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

#### Procedure:

On the audible start signal, engage T1-T5 with two (2) rounds each, perform a mandatory reload and engage T1-T5 with two (2) rounds each.





# Stage 5 - Bus Ride by Bretton Rebol

# WRITTEN STAGE BRIEFING

Welcome to Stage 5 - Bus Ride.

Bus Ride is a 20 round, 100 point FIXED TIME Short course. There are 5 USPSA targets. The start/stop signal is audible.

The start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

On the audible start signal, engage T1-T5 with two (2) rounds each, perform a mandatory reload and engage T1-T5 with two (2) rounds each.







### Stage 6 - Mission Somewhat Possible

Scoring: COMSTOCK, Best 3 hits on cardboard.

Targets: 2 USPSA targets, 2 poppers

Rounds:8

#### **Start Position:**

The start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt.


Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

#### Procedure:

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area. P1 activates Drop Turner DT1 which appears once. P2 activates Drop Out and Back target T1 which disappears.

Misses on paper targets will be NPM's.





# Stage 6 - Mission Somewhat Possible by Bretton Rebol

## WRITTEN STAGE BRIEFING

Welcome to stage Stage 6 - Mission Somewhat Possible.

Mission Somewhat Possible is a 8 round, 40 point COMSTOCK Short course. There are 2 USPSA targets and 2 steel. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt.

Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area. P1 activates Drop Turner DT1 which appears once. P2 activates Drop Out and Back target T1 which disappears.

Misses on paper targets will be NPM's.







Scoring: COMSTOCK, Best 2 hits on cardboard.

Targets: 1 USPSA target, 5 steel

Rounds:7


#### **Start Position:**

The start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt.

Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

Quicky Star is a 7 round, 35 point COMSTOCK Short course. There is 1 USPSA target and 5 steel. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area, facing down range with wrists below belt.

Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.
