

- About 10 miles **south of I-90** (Geneva Exit 218)
- About 2 miles **north of Hartsgrove Circle** (State Route 534 & US-6).

Look for the USPSA Target sign on the west side of SR-534. Follow the gravel road (Speed Limit is **10 mph**!!!) to the ranges at the back of the property. Parking near the pistol bays.

Registration: Squadding on Sunday at 9:00 AM and 1:00 PM. (1:00 PM requires at least 12 shooters willing to stay until teardown is complete and all materials put away in the storage barn). Register online at <u>Practiscore</u>. Sign-in closes ½ hour prior to the squad time. If you are a first-time competitor, please let us know at sign-in. Setup starts on Saturday at 9:00 AM and you can shoot one time after setup is complete.

Cost: Adults - \$20 (non-members) \$15 for Crooked Creek Conservation Club members Juniors (under 18) \$10.00 - Reshoots \$5.00

What do I need? A semi-auto pistol, revolver, or a Pistol Caliber Carbine with a caliber of 9mm/.38 Special or larger, and at least 4 magazines or 6 speed loaders. You will have to reload on most stages. Hearing and eye protection are **REQUIRED** and a baseball style cap is recommended. A sturdy belt, a holster that covers the trigger guard and mag pouches. Bring at least 400 rounds, as we usually shoot six stages with 120-200 rounds required. Matches are conducted in accordance with United States Practical Shooting Association (USPSA) rules. You do not have to be a USPSA member to participate. Join USPSA at a match and your first entry is free. Bring proof of USPSA renewal to get your first entry for free.
