Front Sight

RULES: USPSA Handgun Competition Rules, current edition COURSE DESIGNER: P.R. Metcalf—Modification by US Design Team

START POSITION: Standing in Box A, boths arms hanging relaxed at sides or both wrists above respective shoulders shooter's choice. Handgun is loaded and holstered as per ready condition in rule 8.1.1 and 8.1.2.

STAGE PROCEDURE

String 1. Start facing uprange. Upon start signal, turn, from Box A engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.

String 2. Start facing targets, hand position opposite of string one, upon start signal, from Box A, engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.


SCORING

SCORING: Virginia Count, 12 rounds, 60 points

TARGETS: 3 Metric SCORED HITS: Best 4/paper START - STOP: Audible - Last shot

PENALTIES: Per current edition USPSA Handgun

Competition Rules



SETUP NOTES: Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Box A is 3 feet by 3 feet. Angle T1 and T3 to face shooting box.



CM99-23 FRONT SIGHT

Written Stage Briefing

Front Sight is a 12 round, 60 point, Virginia Count Classifier. There are 3 metric targets. The best 4 hits per target will score. The start signal is audible.

The start position for string one is standing in box A, facing uprange, hands at sides or wrists above shoulders, your choice. Your gun will be loaded and holstered.

The start position for string two is standing in box A, facing the targets, with your hands in the opposite position from string one.

PCC, both strings: standing in Box A, facing downrange, stock on belt, muzzle downrange, loaded carbine held in both hands with safety on.

For both strings, on the start signal engage T1-T3 with only two rounds per target.




Stage 2

Burning Down the House

SCORING: This is a 32 round, 160 point, Comstock course of fire.

TARGETS: 16 USPSA targets.

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA **START-STOP**: Audible - Last shot



CCPL – September 21-22, 2024

Stage 2 – Burning Down the House

This is a 32 round, 160 point, Comstock course of fire consisting of 16 USPSA targets. We will score the best 2 hits per USPSA target and steel must fall to score.

The handgun start position is both feet straddling either start stick and wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

The PCC start position is both feet straddling either start stick. PCC is loaded with safety on, stock on belt and muzzle pointed generally downrange.

On the audible start signal engage targets as available from within the shooting area.


Stage 3 Psycho Killer

SCORING: This is a 24 round, 120 point, Comstock course of fire.

TARGETS: 10 USPSA targets and 4 IPSC Mini Poppers.

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot



CCPL – September 21-22, 2024 Stage 3 – Psycho Killer

This is a 24 round, 120 point, Comstock course of fire consisting of 10 USPSA targets and 4 IPSC Mini poppers. We will score the best 2 hits per USPSA target and steel must fall to score.

The handgun start position is toes of both feet touching the start stick and wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

The PCC start position is toes of both feet touching the start stick. PCC is loaded with safety on, stock on belt and muzzle pointed generally downrange.

On the audible start signal engage targets as available from within the shooting area.




Stage 4 Wild, Wild Life

SCORING: This is a 16 round, 80 point, Comstock course of fire.

TARGETS: 8 USPSA targets.

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA **START-STOP**: Audible - Last shot



CCPL – September 21-22, 2024 Stage 4 – Wild, Wild Life

This is a 16 round, 80 point, Comstock course of fire consisting of 8 USPSA targets. We will score the best 2 hits per USPSA target.

The start position is both feet straddling the start stick and wrists below belt. Firearm is loaded and placed on the table with Trigger guard over the mark and muzzle pointed generally downrange.

On the audible start signal engage targets as available from within the shooting area.


Stage 5

Take Me to the River

SCORING: This is a 22 round, 110 point, Comstock course of fire.

TARGETS: 11 USPSA targets.

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA **START-STOP**: Audible - Last shot



CCPL – September 21-22, 2024 Stage 5 –Take Me to the River

This is a 22 round, 110 point, Comstock course of fire consisting of 11 USPSA targets. We will score the best 2 hits per USPSA target.

The handgun start position is both feet touching either start stick and wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

The PCC start position is both feet touching either start stick. PCC is loaded with safety on, stock on belt and muzzle pointed generally downrange.

On the audible start signal engage targets as available from within the shooting area.


Stage 6

Road to Nowhere

SCORING: This is a 18 round, 90 point, Comstock course of fire. **TARGETS**: 5 USPSA targets, 5 Plates and 3 IPSC Mini Poppers.

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA, steel down = 1A

START-STOP: Audible - Last shot



CCPL – September 21-22, 2024

Stage 6 – Road to Nowhere

This is a 18 round, 90 point, Comstock course of fire consisting of 5 USPSA targets, 5 plates and 3 IPSC Mini poppers. We will score the best 2 hits per USPSA target and steel must fall to score.

The handgun start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area with wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

The PCC start position is standing anywhere in the shooting area. PCC is loaded with safety on, stock on belt and muzzle pointed generally downrange.

On the audible start signal engage targets as available from within the shooting area.
