Stage Procedure

SCORING: Comstock, 10 rounds, 50 points

TARGETS: 5 USPSA Targets

SCORED HITS: Best 2 per USPSA Target

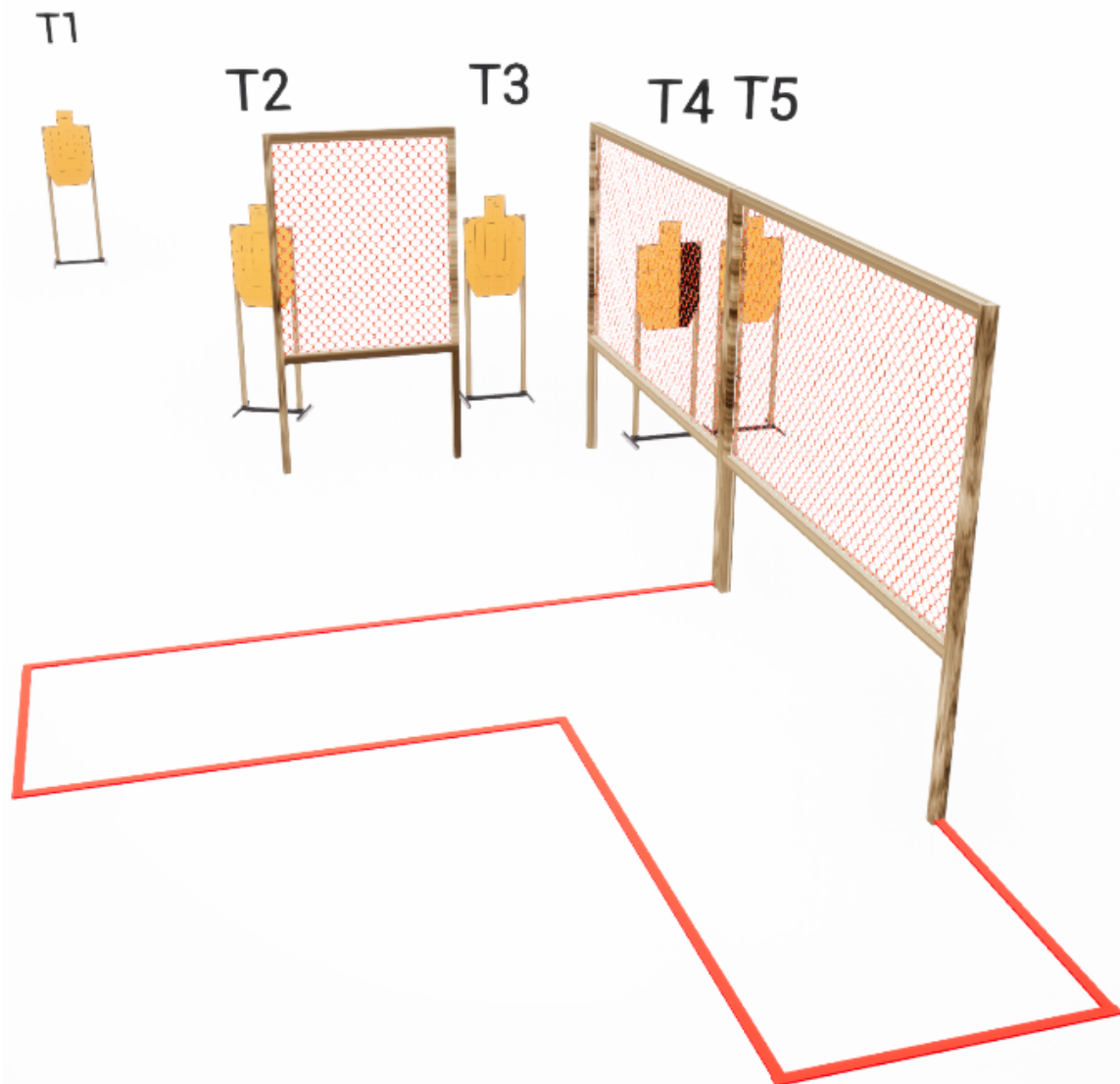
START-STOP: Audible - Last Shot

START POSITION: The **Handgun Start Position** is standing anywhere inside of the shooting area, wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

The **PCC Start Position** is standing anywhere inside of the shooting area. Carbine is loaded with stock on belt.

The **Make Ready** position is at the same location as the Start Position.

PROCEDURE: Upon the start signal, engage the targets from within the shooting area.



Written Stage Briefing

CM 25-02 Look at Me I am the Captain Now is a 10 round, 50 point Comstock Classifier course. There are 5 USPSA targets. The best 2 hits per target will score. The start signal is audible.

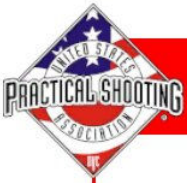
The **Handgun Start Position** is standing anywhere inside of the shooting area, wrists below belt. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

The **PCC Start Position** is standing anywhere inside of the shooting area. Carbine is loaded with stock on belt.

The **Make Ready** position is at the same location as the Start Position.

Upon the start signal, engage the targets from within the shooting area.





Stage 2 - Up and Down

Targets: 11 IPSC targets, 3 poppers, 1 mini popper

Rounds: 26

Start Position:

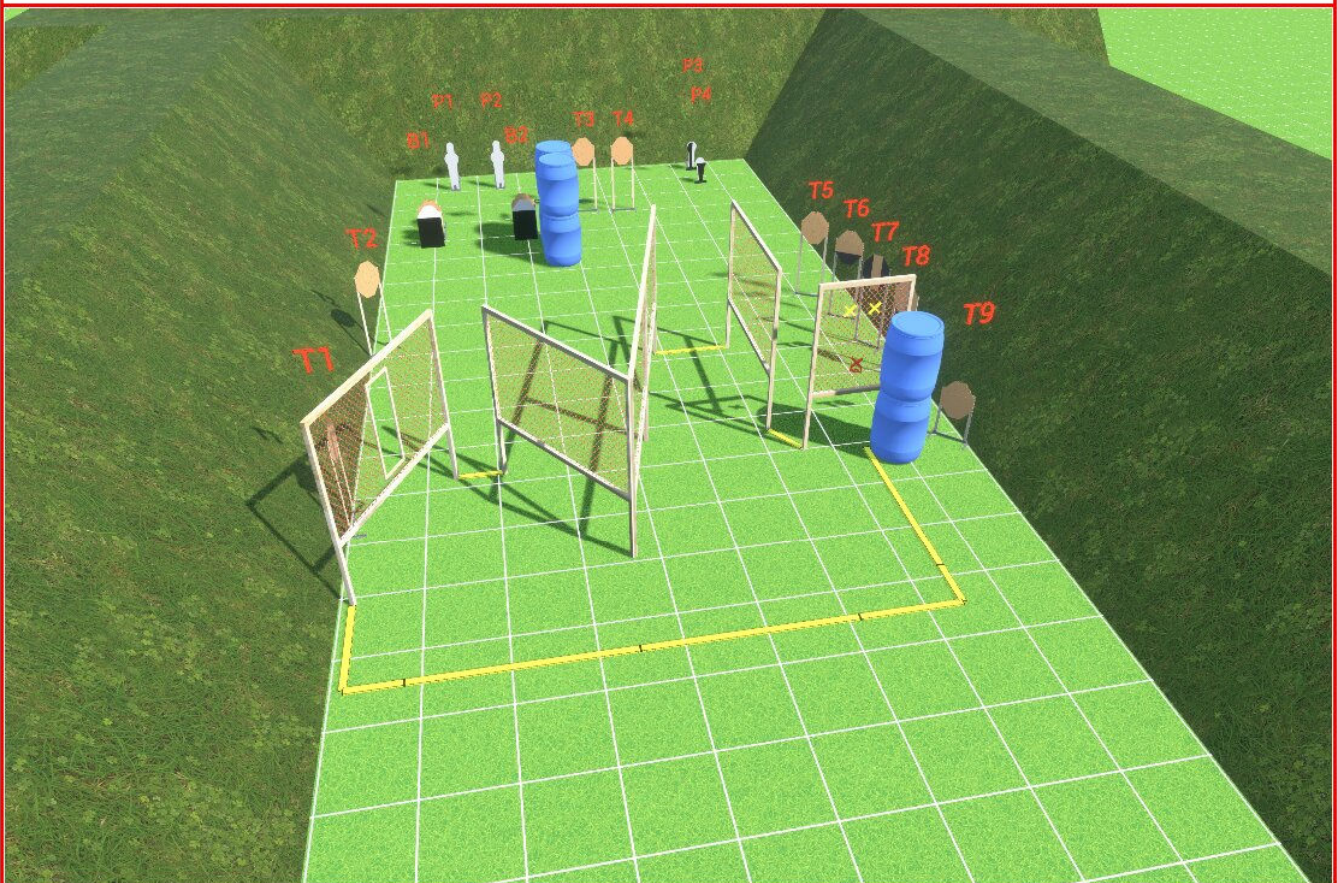
The start position is standing with both hands touching the mark on the wall. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing at lower mark on wall.

Procedure:

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area.

P1 activates Bobber B1 and P2 activates Bobber B2. Both bobbbers are visible at rest.

Welcome to Stage 2 - Up and Down.

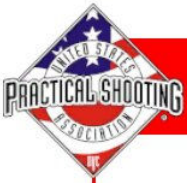
Up and Down is a 26 round, 130 point COMSTOCK Long course. There are 11 IPSC targets and 4 steel. The start signal is audible.

The start position is standing with both hands touching the mark on the wall. Handgun is loaded and holstered.

PCC start position is stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing at lower mark on wall.

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area. P1 activates Bobber B1 and P2 activates Bobber B2. Both bobbars are visible at rest.





Stage 3 - September Blazer

Targets: 15 USPSA targets, 2 poppers

Rounds: 32

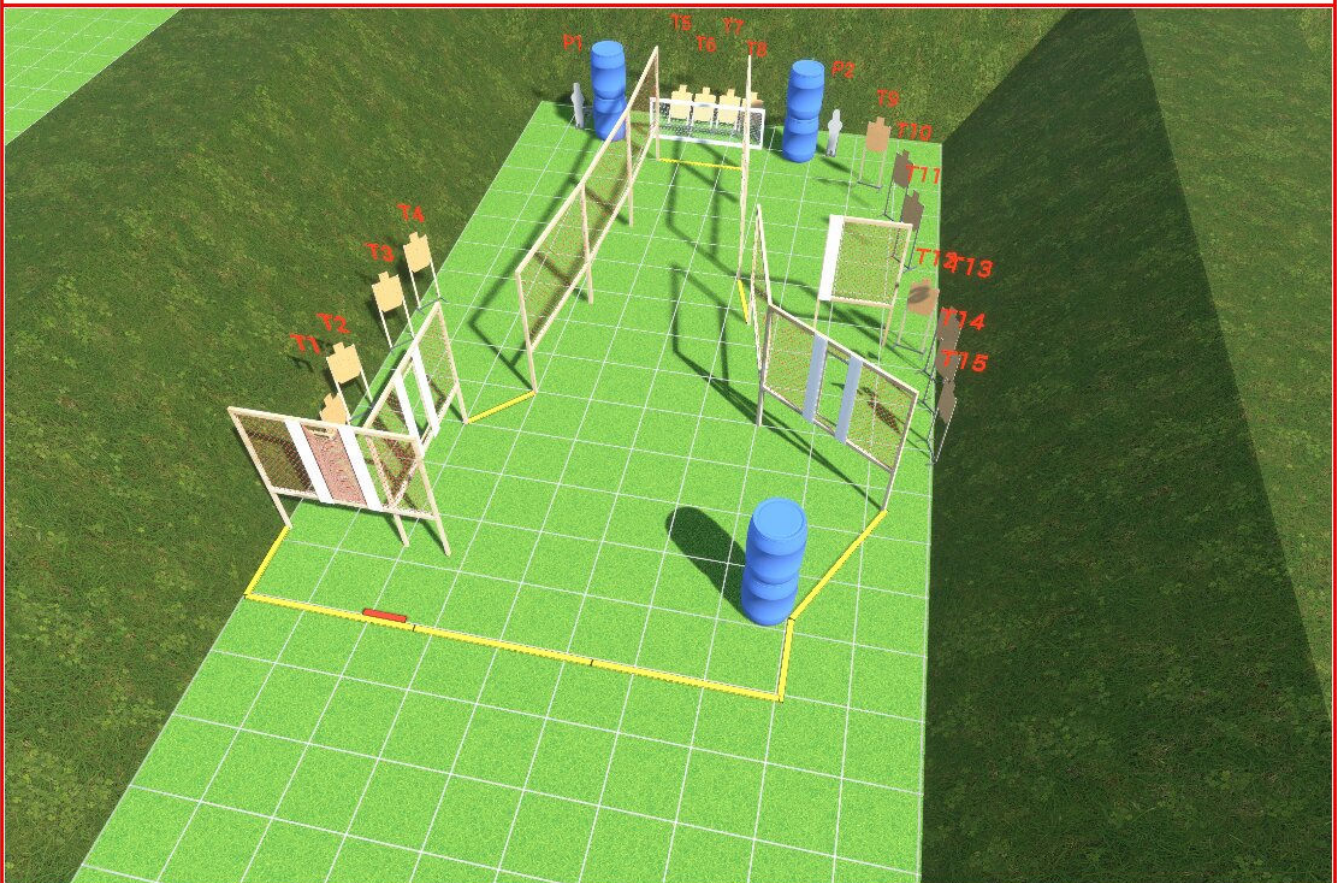
Start Position:

PCC start position is standing with heels touching the start stick, facing down range, stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

Welcome to Stage 3 - September Blazer.

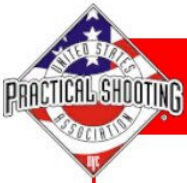
September Blazer is a 32 round, 160 point COMSTOCK Long course. There are 15 USPSA targets and 2 steel. The start signal is audible.

PCC start position is standing with heels touching the start stick, facing down range, stock on belt, safety on, muzzle pointing downrange.

On the audible start signal, engage all targets from within the shooting area.





Stage 4 - Crooked Creek

Start Position:

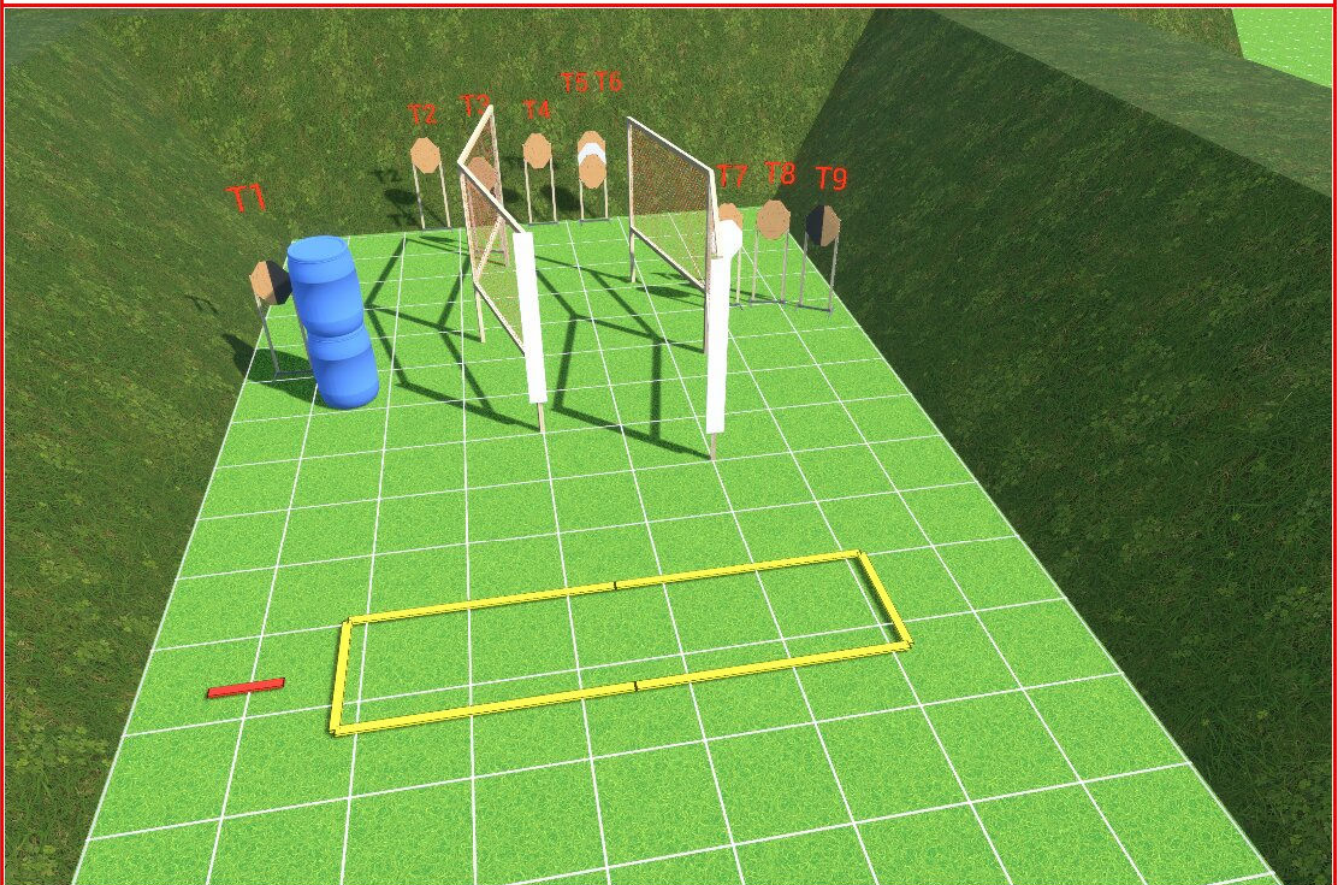
The start position is both feet touching the start stick, facing down range.

Crooked Creek is an 18 round, 90 point VIRGINIA Medium course. There are 9 IPSC targets. The start signal is audible.

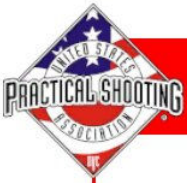
The start position is both feet touching the start stick, facing down range.

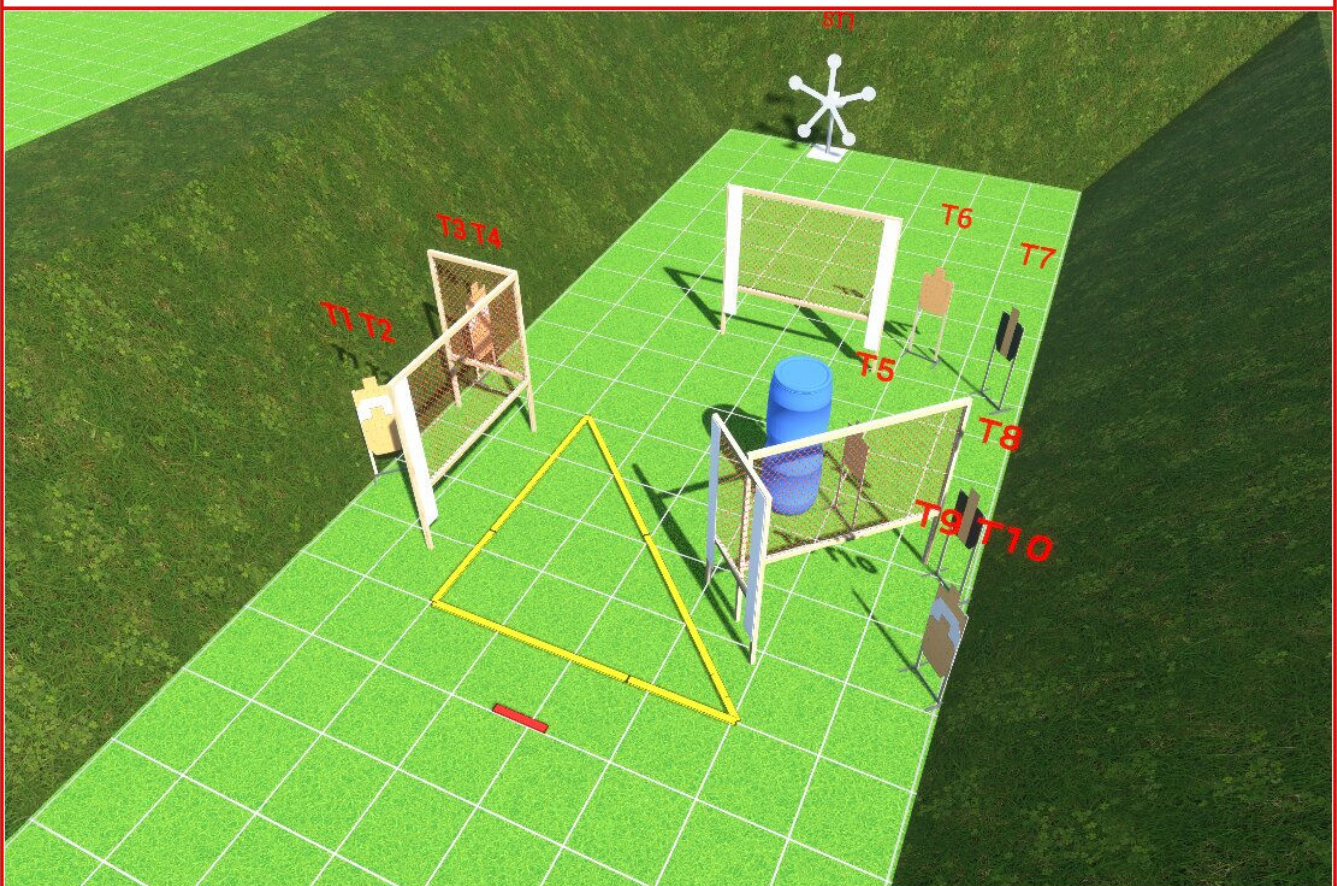

No Straight Answers is a 25 round, 125 point COMSTOCK Long course. There are 10 USPSA targets and 5 steel. The start signal is audible.

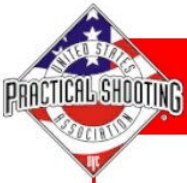
The start position is standing with toes of both feet touching the start stick, facing down range.

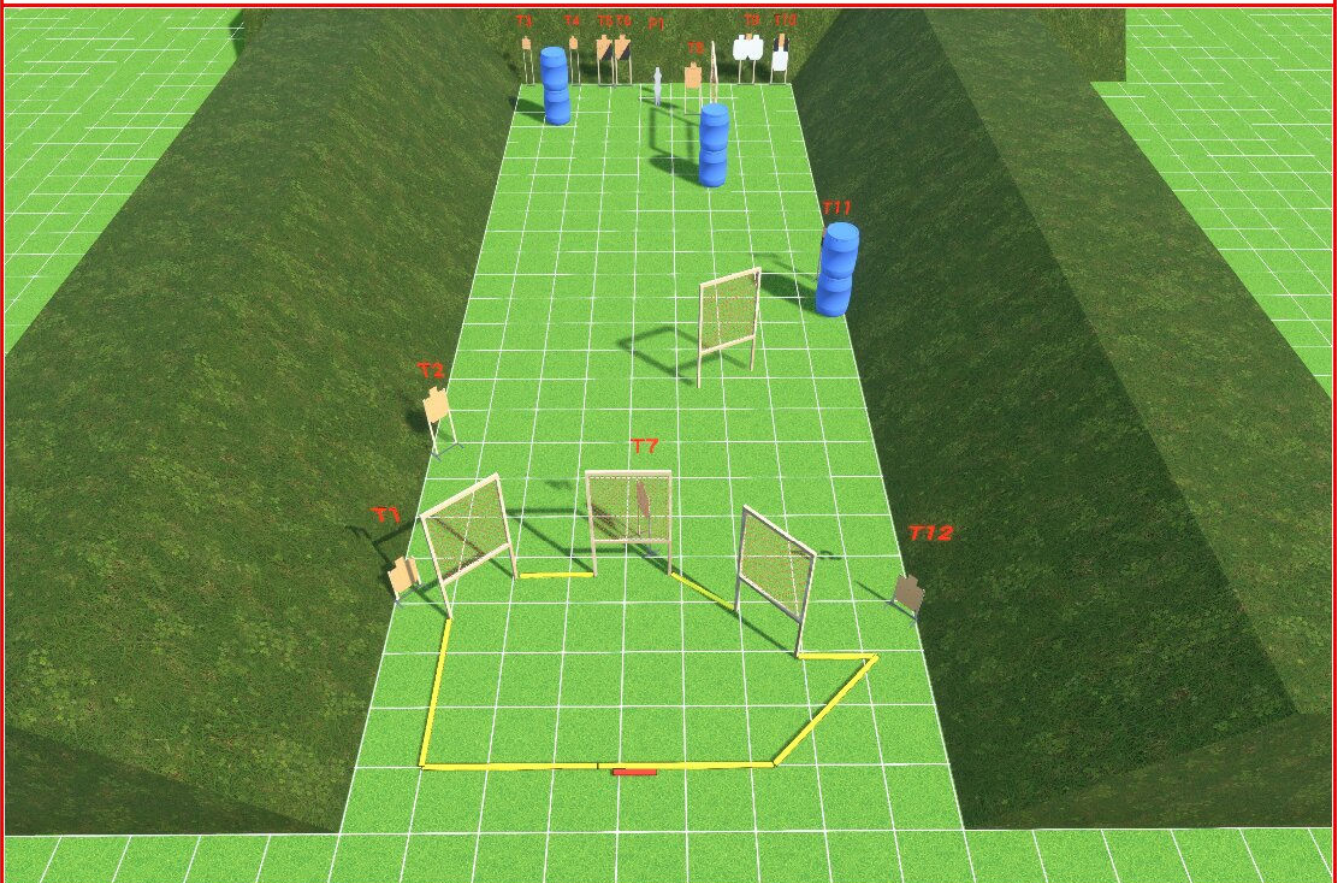
